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# 1. Important information - safety

## General installation conditions

Before installing this product, read these instruction guidelines and safety information carefully.

This product must be installed and commissioned by a professional in home motorisation and automation, in accordance with SIMU instructions and applicable regulations in the country where it is installed.

The installer must inform its customers about conditions for using and maintaining the product.

Any use outside the scope of application specified by SIMU is prohibited. In the event of any such use or failure to comply with the instructions given in these guidelines, SIMU will not be held liable and the guarantee will be invalidated. Before use, check that the product is compatible with the associated equipment and accessories.

## Safety instructions

In order not to damage the LiveIn product:

- Avoid shocks and dropping the product.
- Do not spray or immerse in liquid.
- Do not use abrasive products or solvents to clean it. Its surface may be cleaned with a soft dry cloth.
- Do not open the device.
- Do not place the product outside the building.
- Keep the LiveIn away from all metal surfaces that could adversely affect its operation (reduced range).
- Using radio devices working on the same frequencies (e.g.: radio hi-fi headphones) can reduce the performance of LiveIn.

This product is not designed to be used by people (including children) with impaired physical, sensory or mental capacity, or inexperienced or uninformed people, unless they can be supervised by or receive prior instruction about using this product from a person responsible for their safety.

In accordance with standard EN 12453, relating the safety in use of power-operated doors and gates, if the LiveIn plug is used to operate an automated garage door or gate that cannot be seen by the operator, a safety device must be fitted on this automated system. ## Scope of application

The LiveIn system is used to operate motorised equipment such a roller shutters, blinds and garage doors equipped with safety device to protect against hazards caused by crushing, shearing, lifting and drawing-in points. This system can also control equipment fitted with Simu radio-Hz micro-receivers.

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## 2. Introduction to LiveIn

### Overview

LiveIn is a connected solution providing local and remote control of SIMU-Hz radio equipment from a smartphone or tablet.

The LiveIn solution comprises :

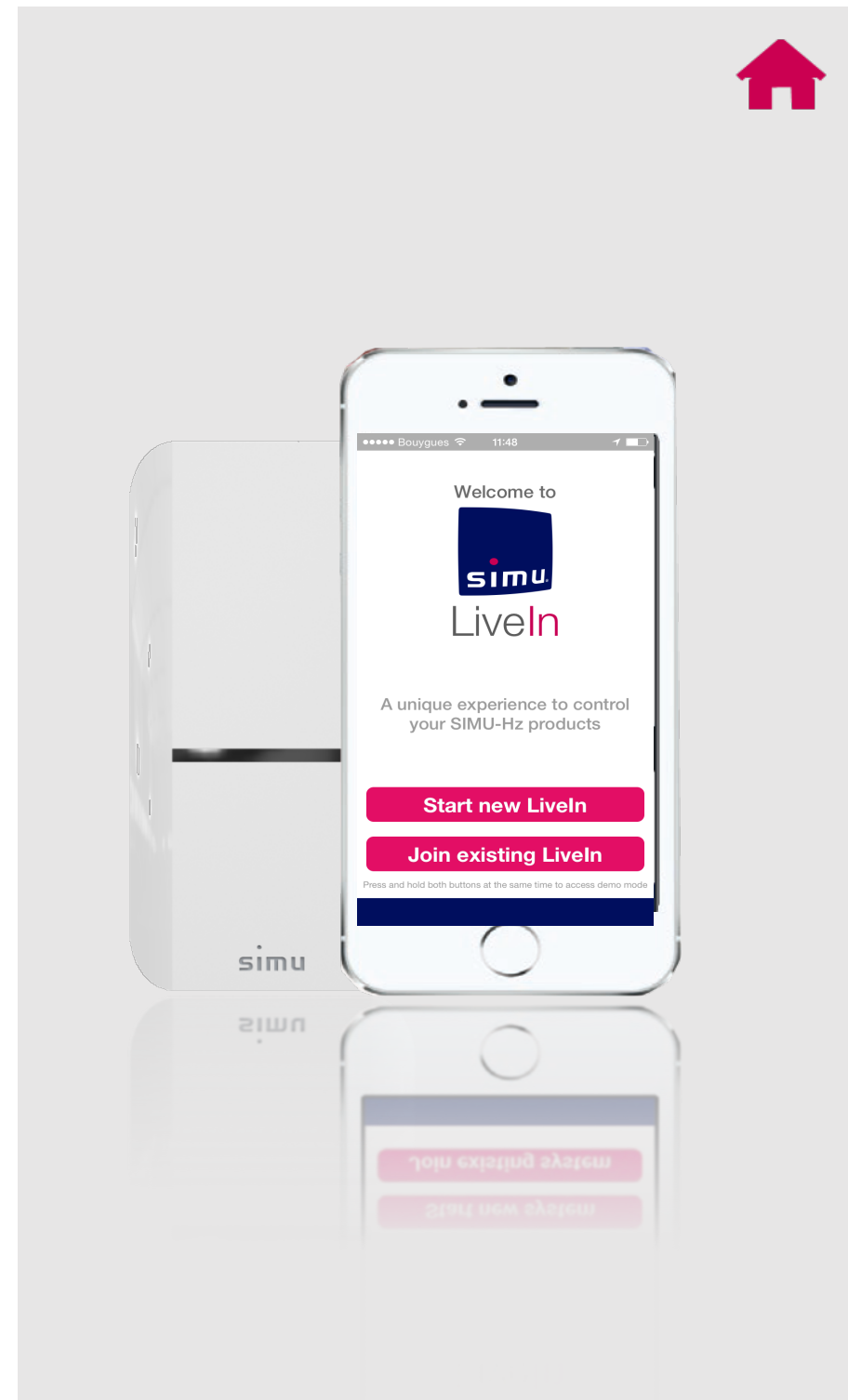
- A WiFi/Simu-Hz connected plug to be inserted into a mains socket to operate installed Simu-Hz equipment. The LiveIn plug must be installed close to the WiFi router and at the centre of the Simu-Hz equipment (refer to the list of compatible equipments on [simu.com](http://simu.com)).
- A free downloadable multi-lingual application compatible with iOS and Android smartphones.

The solution is used to connect:

- Up to 5 LiveIn plugs
- Several Smartphones/tablet (unlimited number)

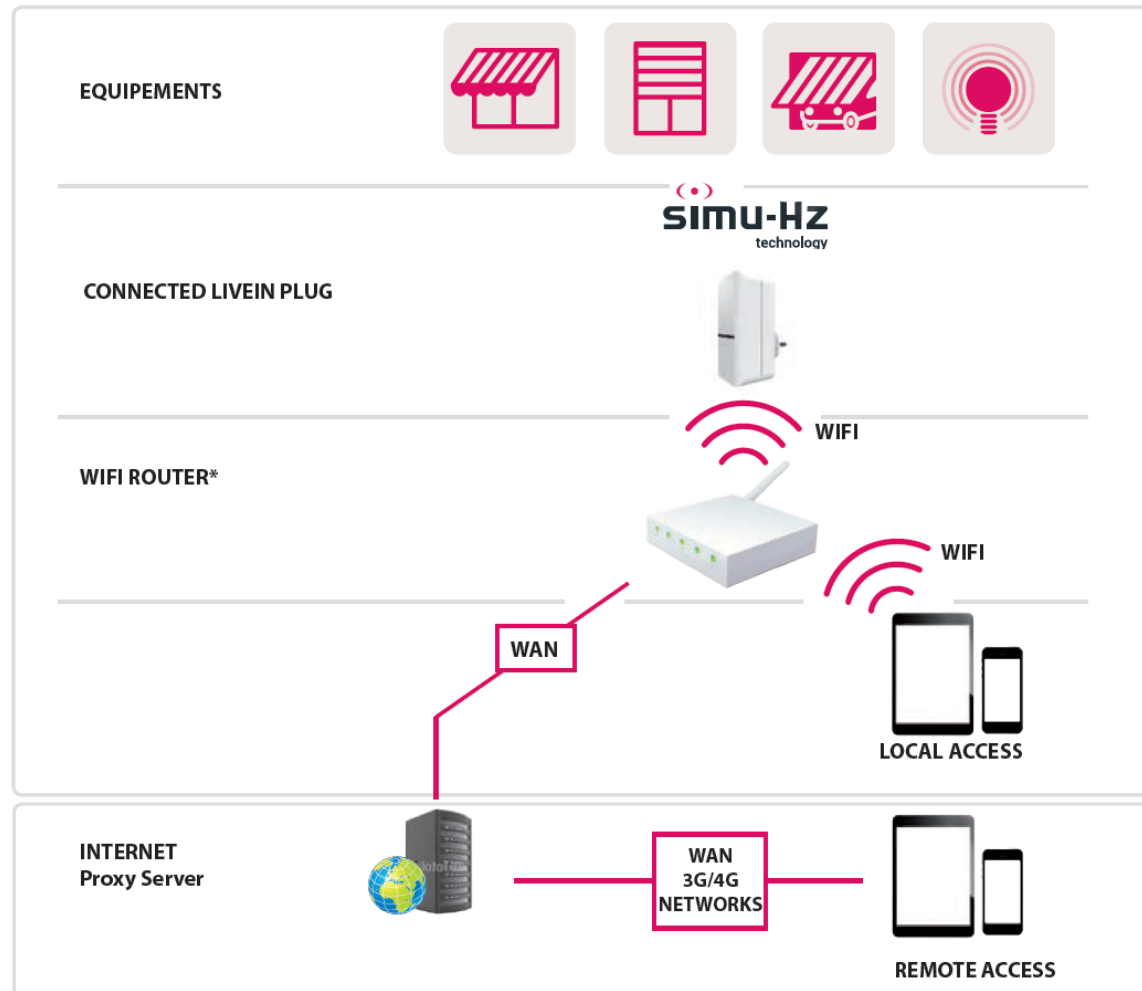
Each LiveIn plug allows:

- Direct control of 25 pieces or groups of equipment with your mobile
- Starting customised scenarios manually (25 possible scenarios)
- Starting scenarios automatically with 25 possible time clocks.

\*for a single local acces is only required a WIFI router (no need an internet connexion)


## 2. Introduction to LiveIn

### Protection of the LiveIn system

Security of the LiveIn system is provided by a 4-digit PIN code specific to the installation. This LiveIn PIN code is generated automatically when the unit is configured. All LiveIn plugs of the installation have the same PIN code. It is available from the main menu, option 'Edit'. Commands are encrypted for greater security. We recommend changing your PIN code regularly.

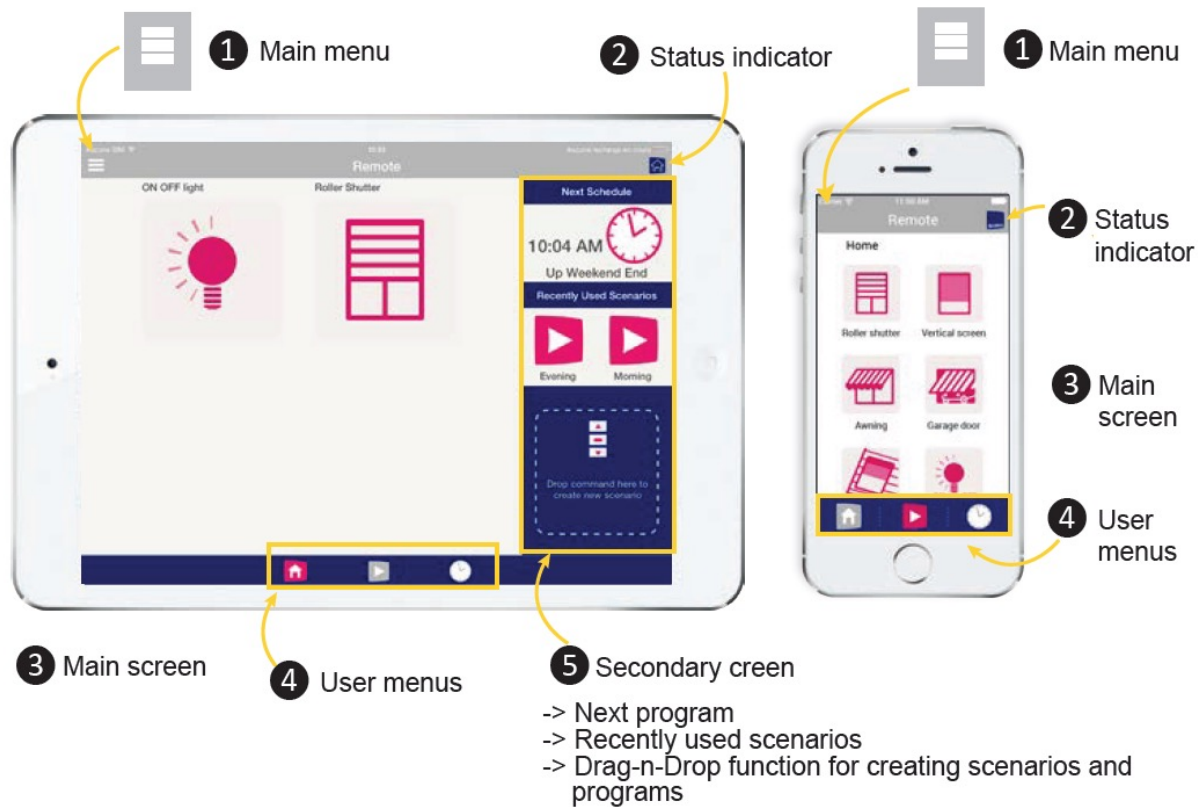

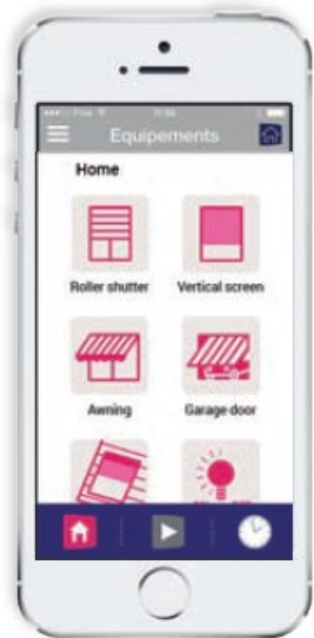

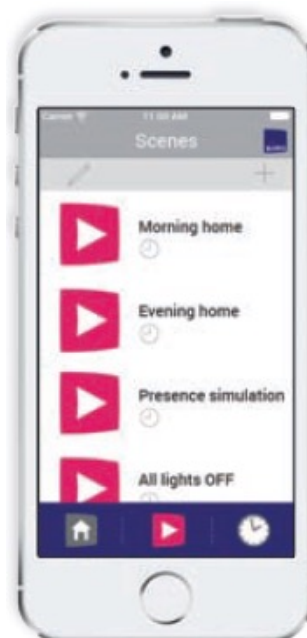
### User menus



#### Manual operation of Equipment

Direct operation of your equipment or equipment groups.

- The equipment to be operated is customised (name + icon)
- Up to 25 equipment items or equipment groups
- 4 actions: raise, stop lower, favourite position (if allowed by the motor).



#### Create and start Scenarios

Successively run a sequence of commands on your equipment.

- Up to 25 customised scenarios
- Command = equipment item + direction of movement  
e.g.: 'going out' scenario that closes all roller shutters and turns off lights



#### Time clock programs

Your scenarios are run automatically in your absence.

- Up to 25 advance time clocks
- Dawn and dusk function*
- Simulate presence in the house*
- Automatic summer time change*
- Option to individually disable time clocks



## 2. Introduction to LiveIn

### Requirements for installation

IMPORTANT : the LiveIn system can only be added to a SIMU-Hz installation if the equipment to be operated is already programmed and previously fitted with an individual SIMU-Hz control point.

- Compatible iOS (Version 8 and above: iPhone 4S or newer) and Android (Versions 4.1 and above) smartphone or tablet
- 230V-120V / 50 Hz power supply, compatible type C, E or F electrical sockets
- 1 local wifi router for local operation (router operating on 2.4 GHz networks) / 1 internet access point for remote operation.

### Check list before installation

- Confirm that the Simu-Hz motorized products are fully operational from at least 1 Simu-Hz control point and that all the limits are set (including the favourite position if desired).
- Make sure that the wifi network is 2.4GHz and is using a LiveIn-supported encryption type (WEP, WPA2, open mode).  
NOTE : All the residential Internet boxes answer these criteria by default
- Check the wifi strength at the location you want to install LiveIn plug. Connect your mobile device to the network you want the LiveIn to join and see how strong the signal is.
- Know your wifi network name (SSID) and password (if required).

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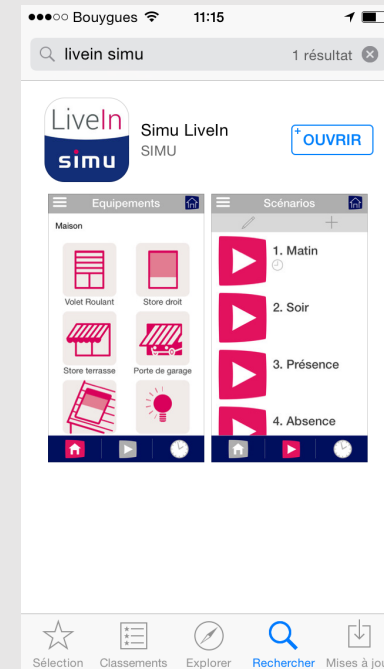

### 3. LiveIn installation

#### Configure the Wifi network

##### Step 1

**1** Click on “Start new LiveIn”

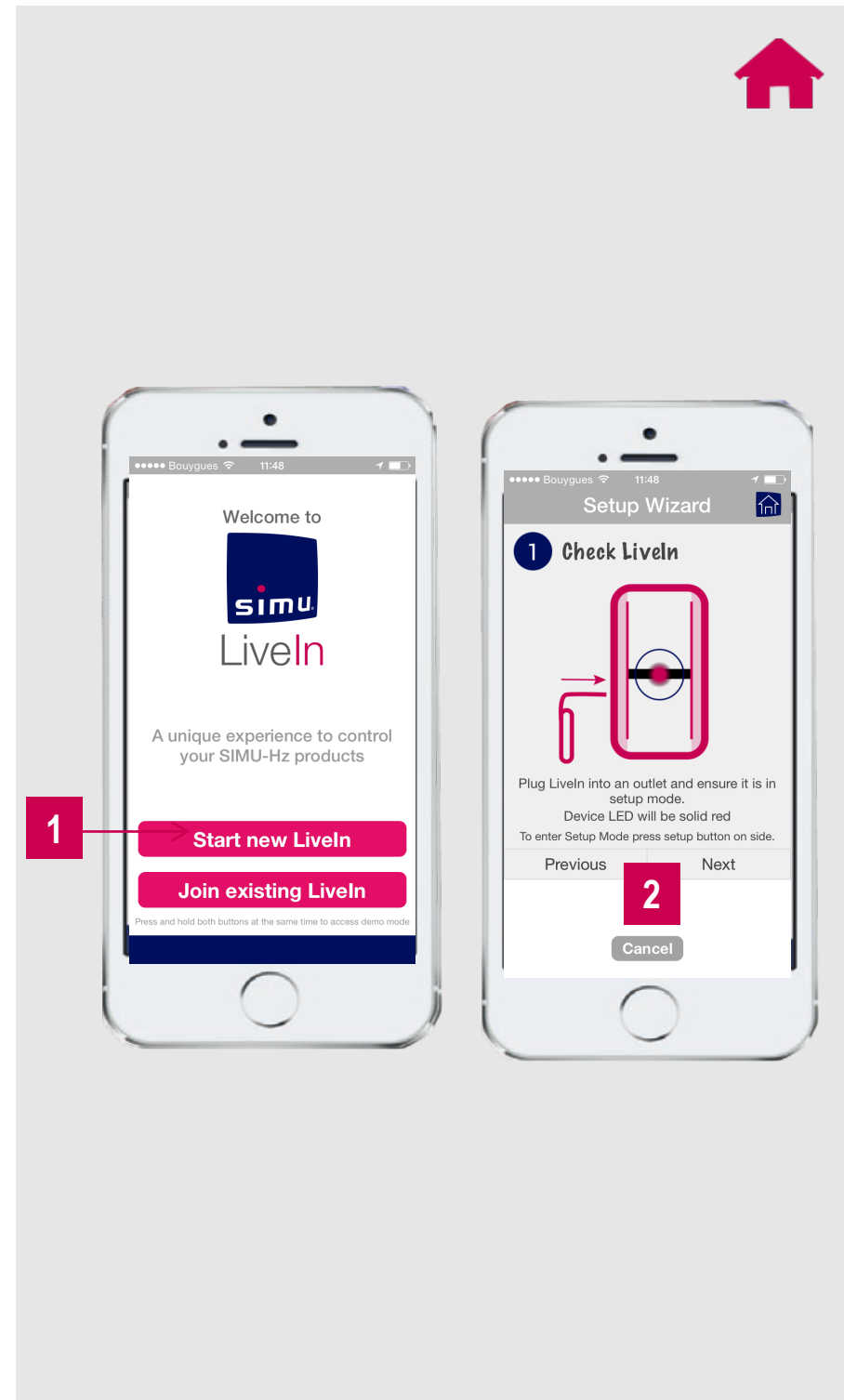
**2** Put in the LiveIn plug into a mains socket. Ensure that the LED is steady red in colour.

(If the LED is green, reset the plug using the reset button: a single press is required).

LiveIn is in configuration mode and broadcasts a temporary WiFi network Simu\_####



A LiveIn plug that would have been reset once has a configuration mode (red LED) that lasts 2mns only.

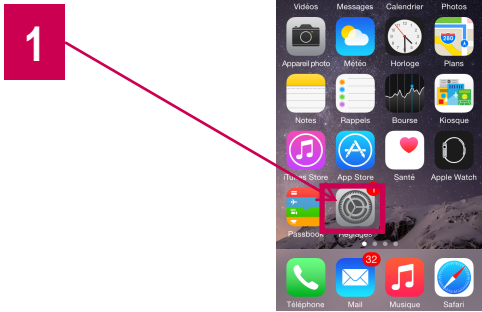
#### Configure the Wifi network

##### Step 2

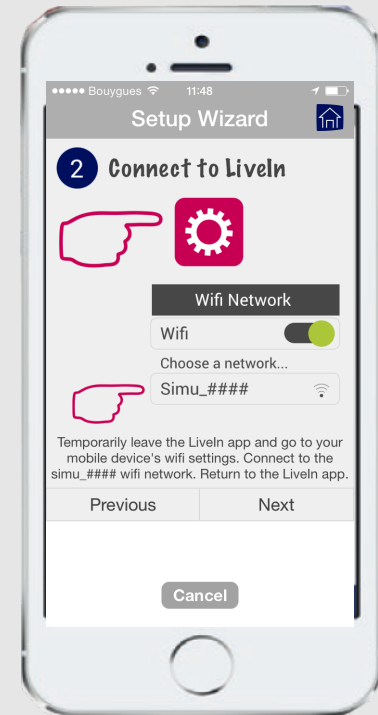
**1** Go to your mobile device's WiFi settings.

**2** Connect you to the WiFi network Simu\_####

Ex. Iphone



It takes a few seconds for the WiFi to appear on the Simu-#### plug.



## 3. LiveIn installation

### Configure the Wifi network

#### Step 3

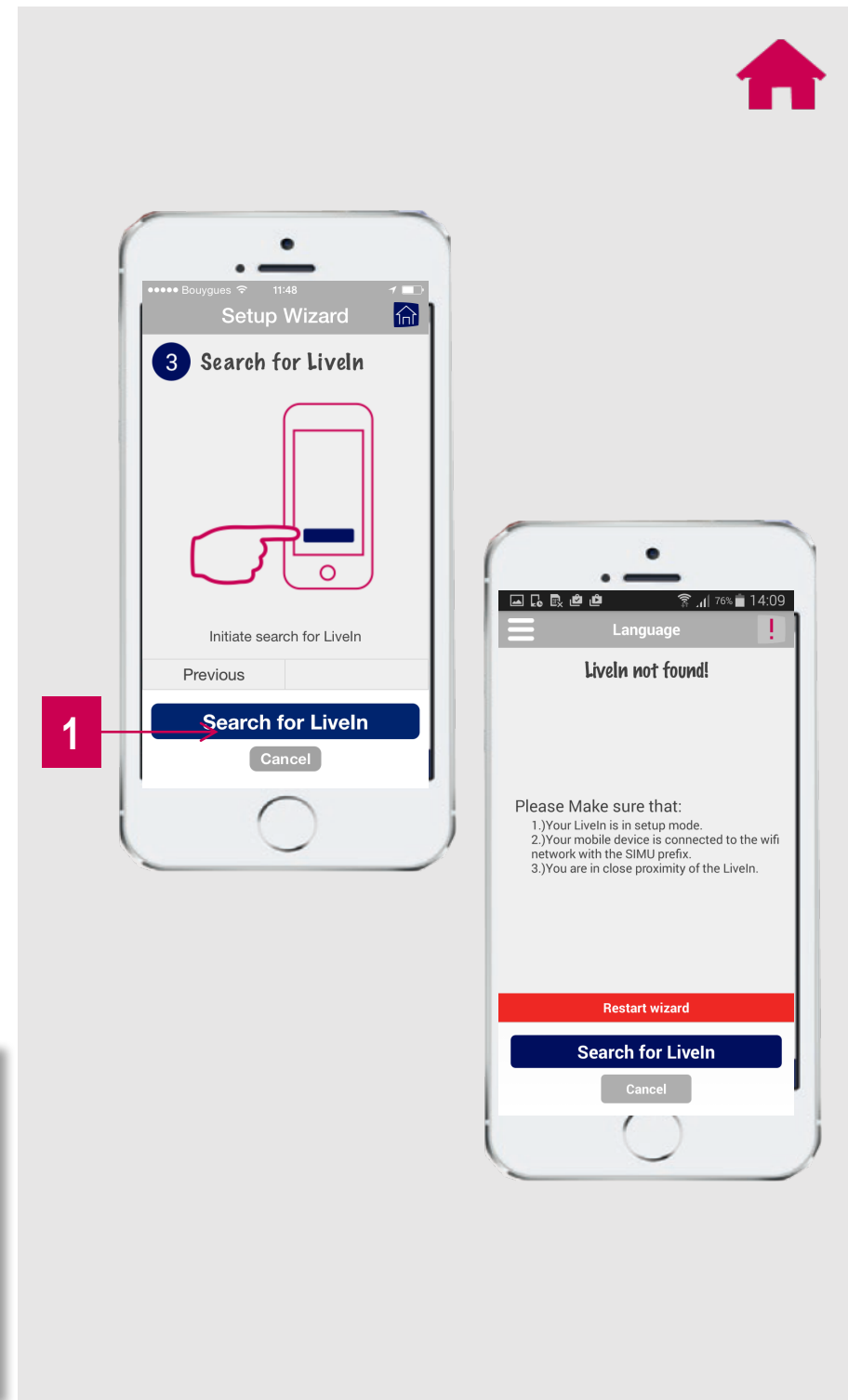
➤ Once your mobile device is connected to the network Simu\_####, a button “Search for LiveIn” appears in the setup wizards.

**1** Click “Search for LiveIn”



#### IF ERROR« NO LIVEIN DEVICE FOUND »

- 1) Check status of the LED on the LiveIn plug. It has to be red.
- 2) Check that your smartphone is still connected to the network of LiveIn plug simu\_####
- 3) Check that the LiveIn plug is installed close enough to the WiFi router  
Make it closer if needed



## 3. LiveIn installation

### Configure the Wifi network

#### WiFi network

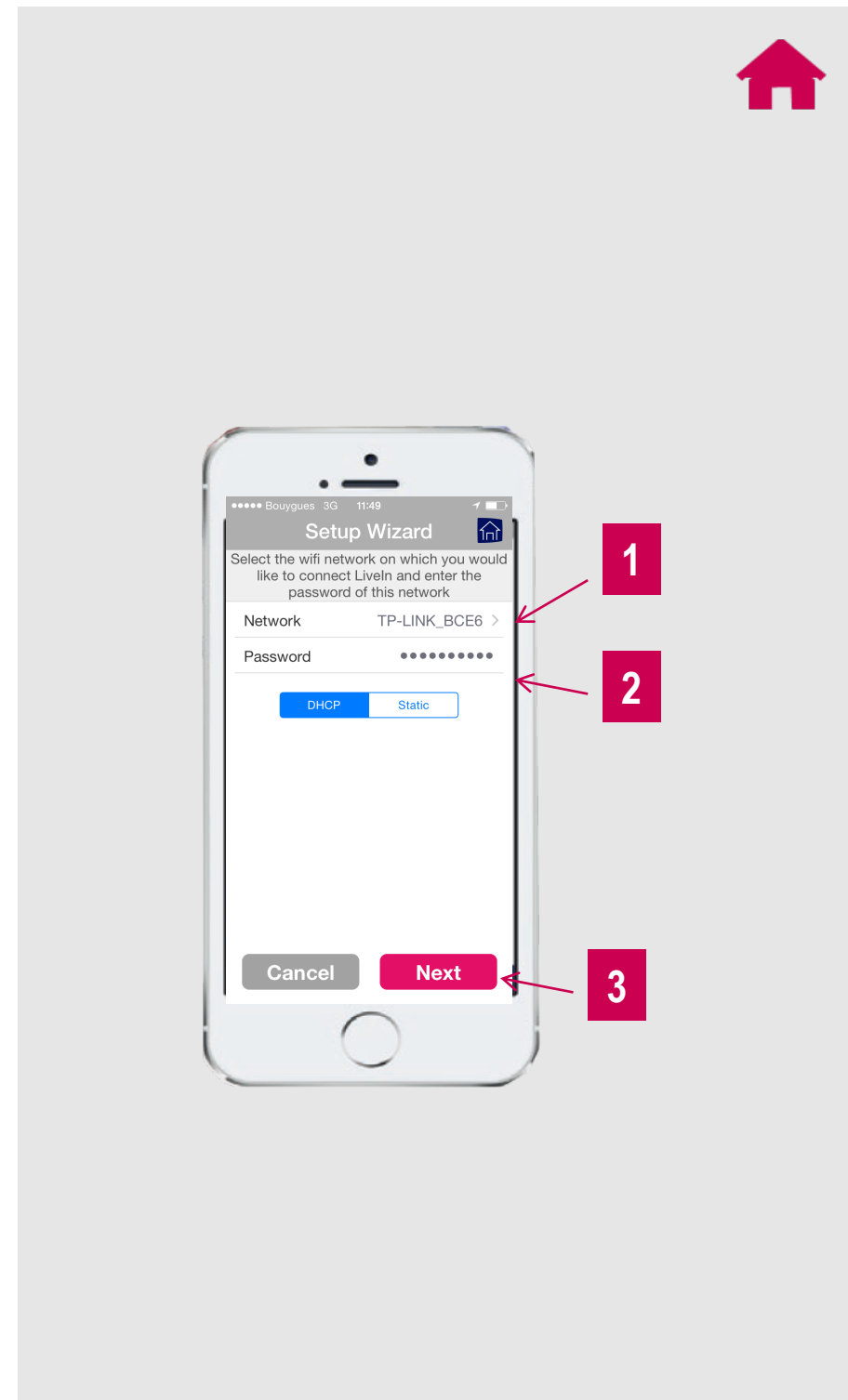
- 1 Choose in the list your domestic WiFi network

*If it doesn't appear, you can refresh network list by re-engaging configuration mode of the plug (red LED = single press on reset button)*

*DO NOT look for the Simu\_#### network*

- 2 Enter your WiFi password

- 3 Click next

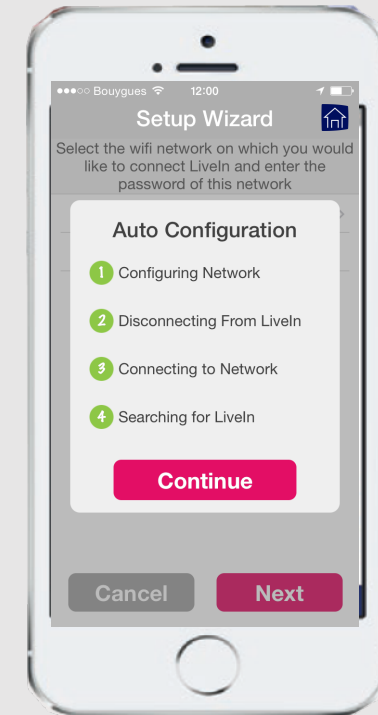


## 3. LiveIn installation

### Configure the Wifi network

#### Auto Configuration

- 1 Sends network info to LiveIn, LiveIn reboots and joins network
- 2 Mobile device disconnects from the LiveIn setup network (Simu\_####); Simu\_#### disappears
- 3 Mobile device connects to same network as LiveIn
- 4 Mobile device receives LiveIn broadcast



## 3. LiveIn installation

### Configure Wifi network– possible error messages

#### Error #3

➤ The WiFi network on which your mobile device is connected is not the same as the LiveIn's

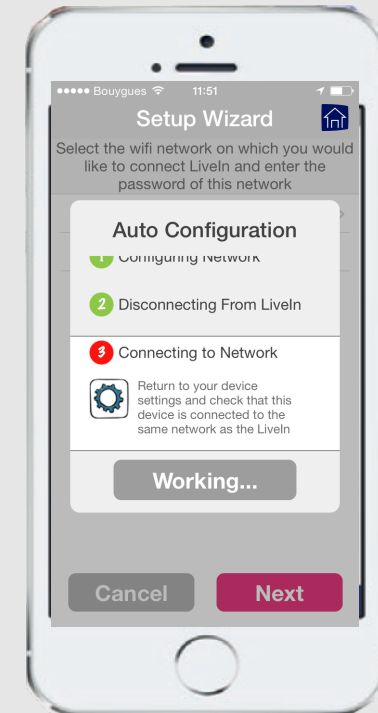
➤ Access mobile device's network settings and make sure that it is connected to the same network as the LiveIn's = your home WiFi network

➤ Unless the network is the mobile devices default, it will not always automatically rejoin

➤ Join the right network and then return on the LiveIn app; auto configuration process will continue.



If you know that the network of LiveIn plug is not your default one , don't wait for the error message and go to your mobile device's settings to choose the right network





## 3. LiveIn installation

### Configure Wifi network– possible error messages

#### Error #4

➤ Means the LiveIn and mobile device are on the same network but can't find each other

A. If LiveIn is solid green, it's MOST LIKELY a network issue

>Wait so that communications are handed

>Restart the wizard if problem persists

B. If LiveIn is blinking green, possible causes are :

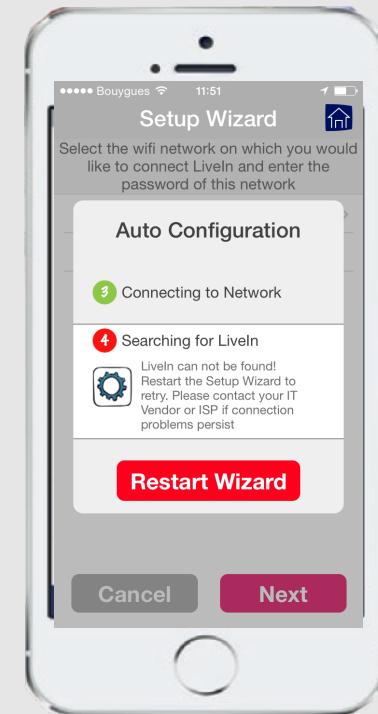
A. WiFi password might have been typed incorrectly

> Restart the setup wizards and do it again

B. Network isn't compatible with the LiveIn

>Check again network compatibility

(2.4 Ghz, cryptage standard WPA2)

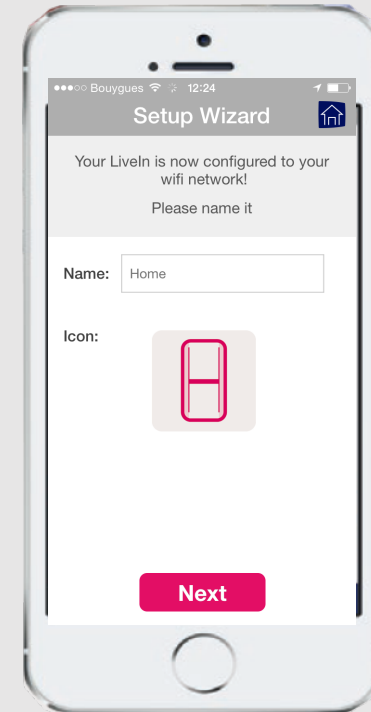
Program the Simu-Hz equipments

### LiveIn plug

➤ Give a name to the LiveIn you just configured



In a case of a LiveIn system with several plugs, this name will help you to identify each plug  
Ex. Ground floor, 1st floor  
Ex. Home, Office

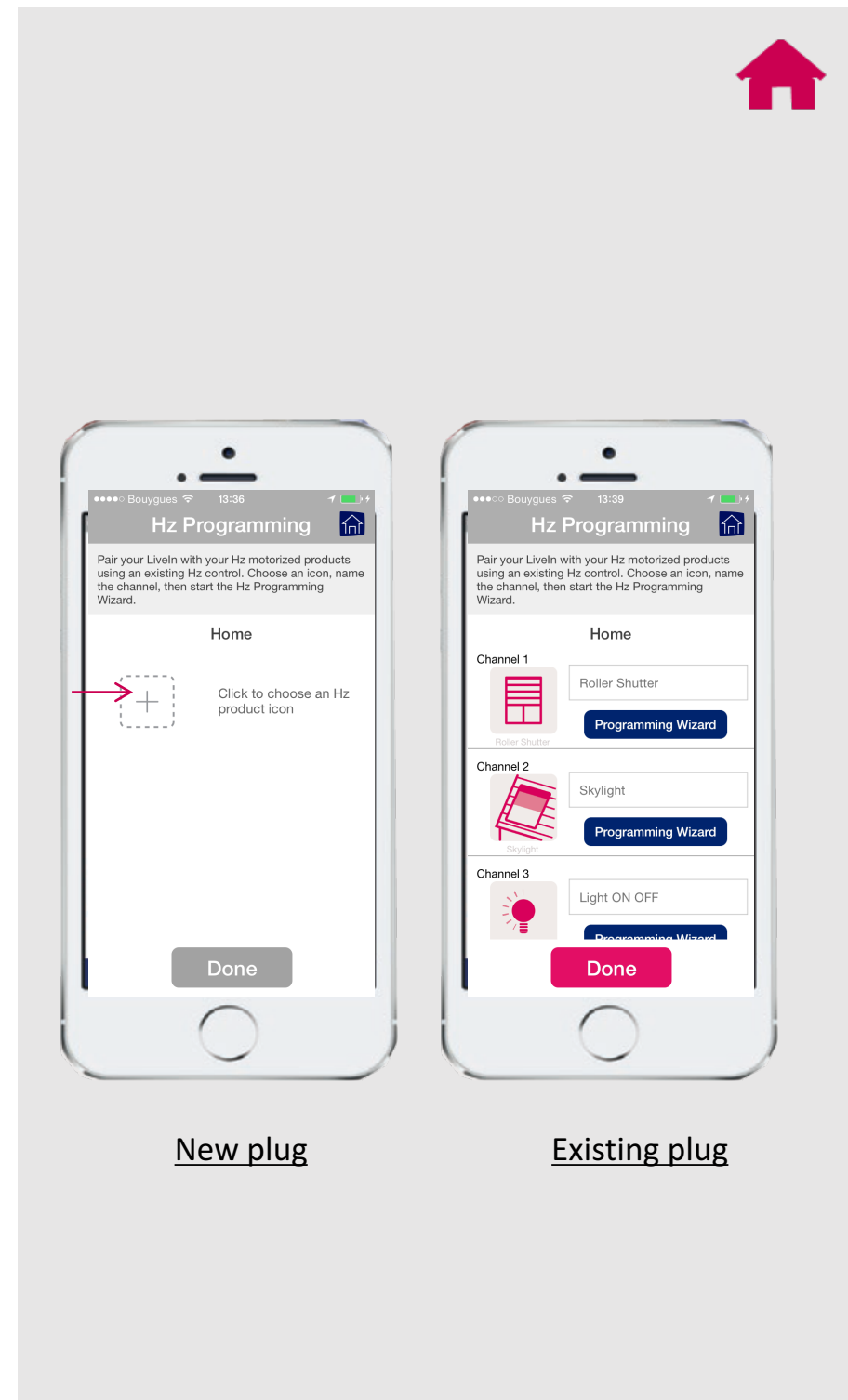
### Program the Simu-Hz equipments

#### List of your equipments

- From this screen, you can edit and add Simu-Hz equipment of your choice
- Each LiveIn plug can contain up to 25 channels
  - 1 channel can contain a device or a group of devices Simu-Hz
- For a new LiveIn plug, click the + to add a first equipment



We recommend that you have thought through the channels before programming; these channels will then be displayed in user mode in the order of their creation.

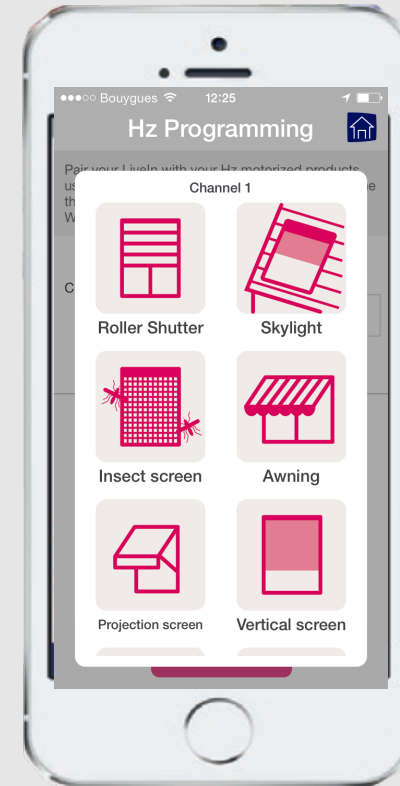
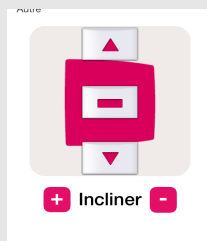
#### Choice of the equipment icon

- Select the icon for your equipment
  - You have a choice of 11 available icons. From the icon depends on the type of control that you will get
- (see document "list of compatible devices" for recommendations)

### Program the Simu-Hz equipments

#### Step 0

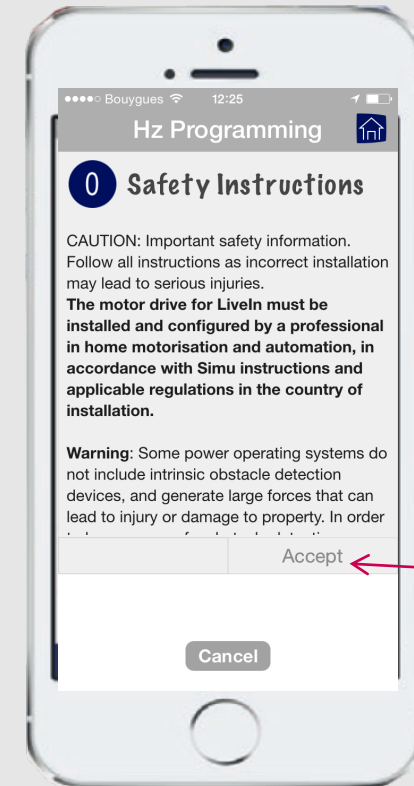
➤ The first screen recalls the important safety information to the professional who performs the installation of Simu-Hz equipment and LiveIn plug

**1** Read the text entirely (scroll down)

**2** Accept



It is important to read these instructions before programming Simu-Hz equipment on the solution LiveIn

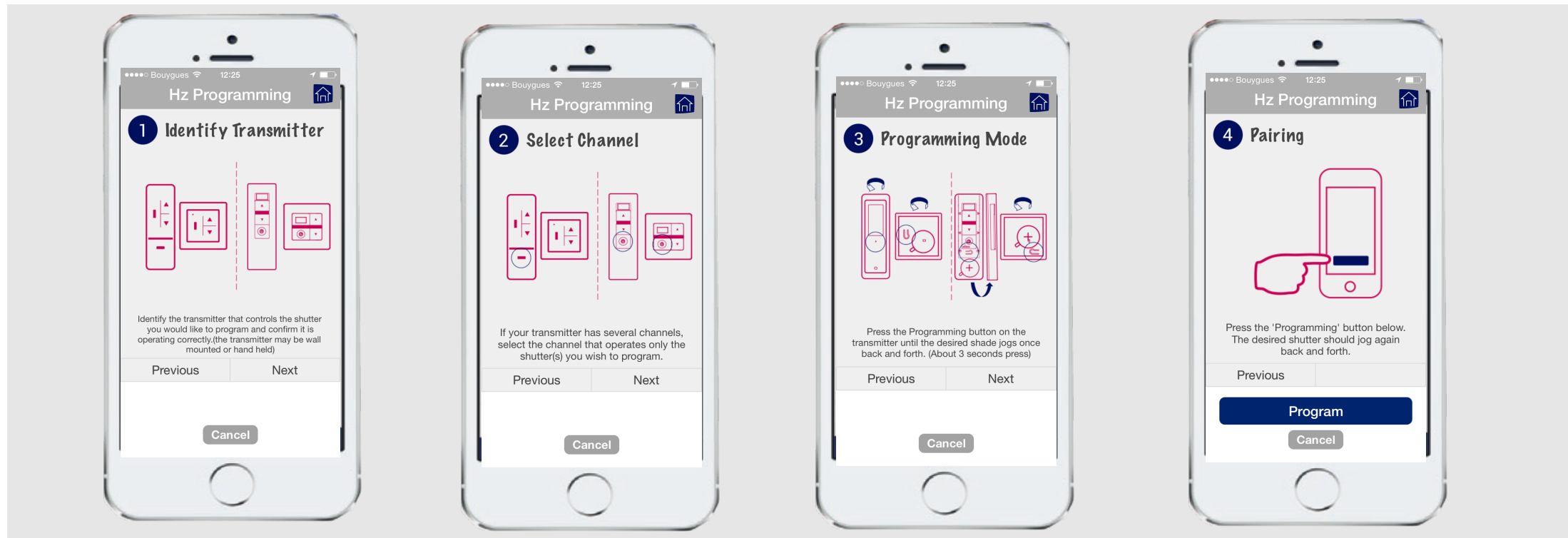


## 3. LiveIn installation

### Program the Simu-Hz equipments

#### Step 1 to 4

➤ Swipe through 4 wizard screens, “program” appears on last



➤ Programming Simu-Hz equipment is done the same way than a transmitter on a jobsite.

## 3. LiveIn installation

### Program the Simu-Hz equipments

#### Confirm screen

➤ This screen allows you to test the operation of the command

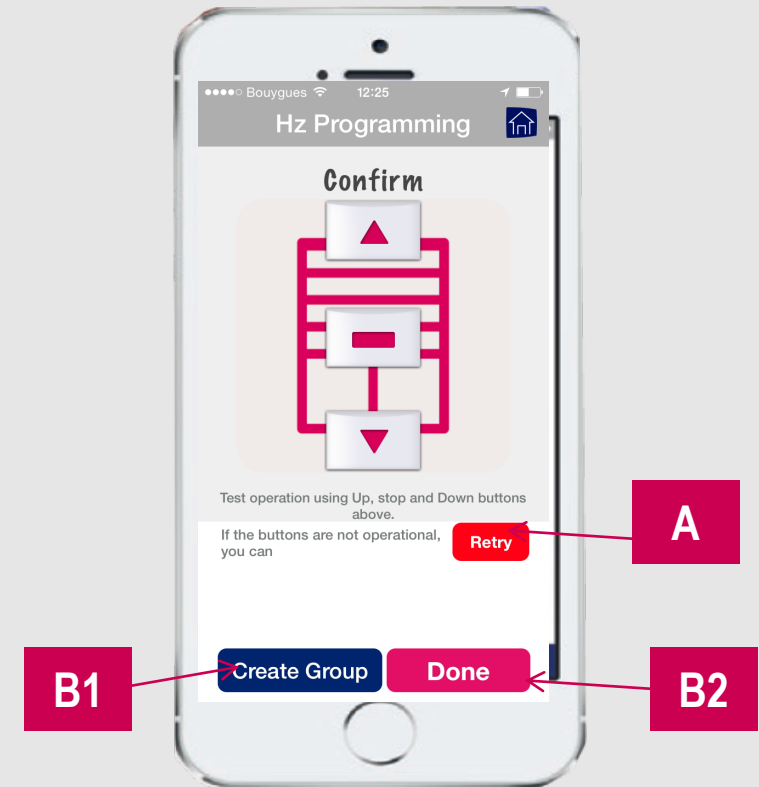
**A** If the command does not work, click “retry”

**B** If the command works well, you can either:

1. Create a group and so pair a new device on the channel (step 1 to 4)
2. Click “done” and finalize the creation of the channel



We recommend you to test the operation of the equipment before validating the channel. Because a previous jog isn't always a guarantee of proper operation



## 3. LiveIn installation

### Program the Simu-Hz equipments

#### Rename the channel

**1** Remember to rename the channel  
(Max 21 characters will appear)

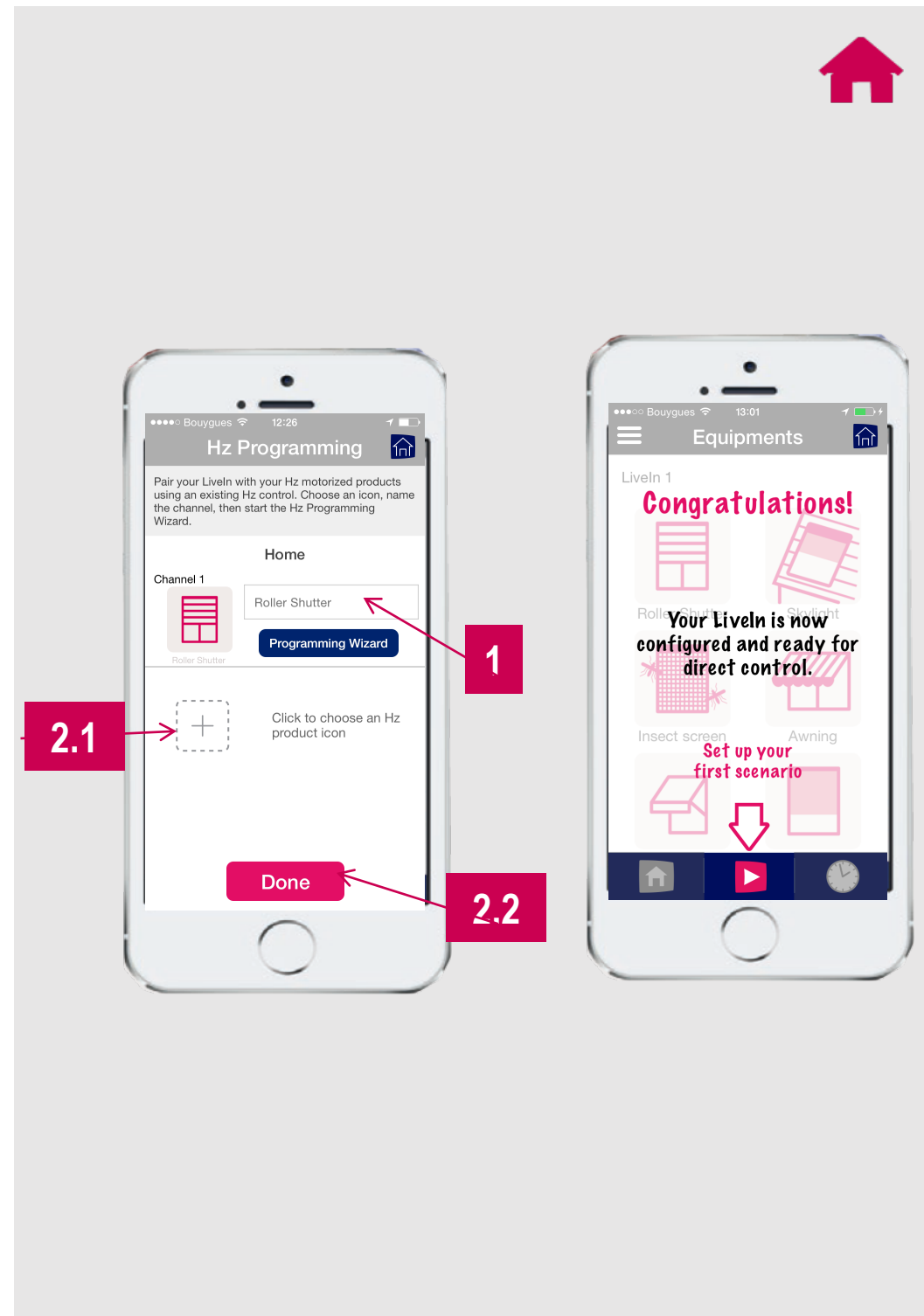
**2** Then, you can choose to

1. Create a new channel
2. Validate and permanently store your device list by pressing the “done”

*You exit the Simu-Hz programming and access the user mode on “congratulations screen”*



If setup process is interrupted before Congrats screen, **MUST** start from the beginning (configuration mode)

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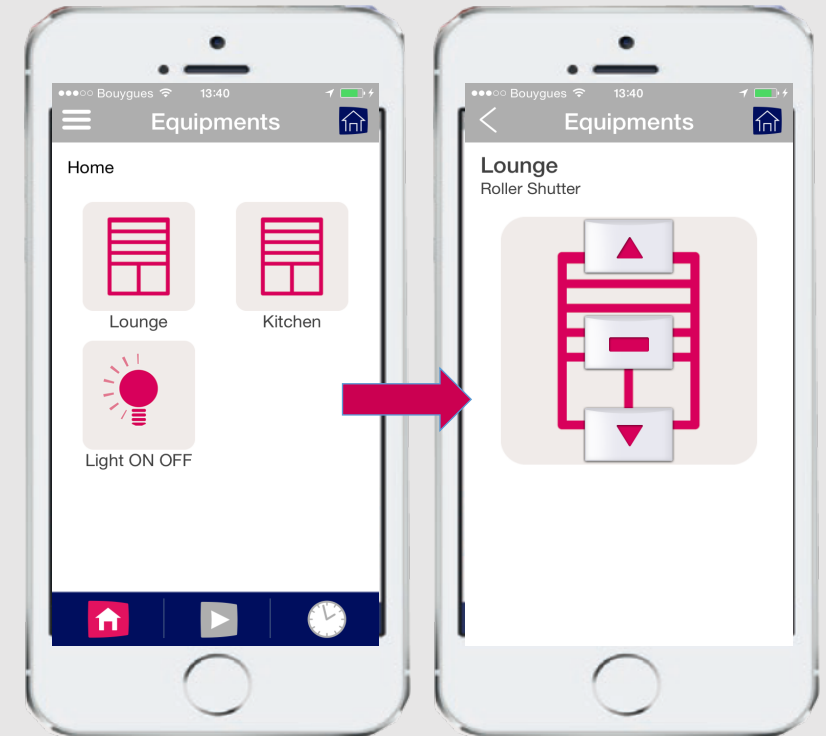

- From the equipments menu, choose the device icon you want to control by clicking on it
- Then select the control command that you want to send by clicking on it  
*Screen is gray time of sending the command*



Depending on the environment and the quality of your WiFi at the time of your order, sending the order may take more or less time.

Ex : Morning scenario that opens all roller shutters

Ex : Evening scenario that closes all roller shutters and turns on lights

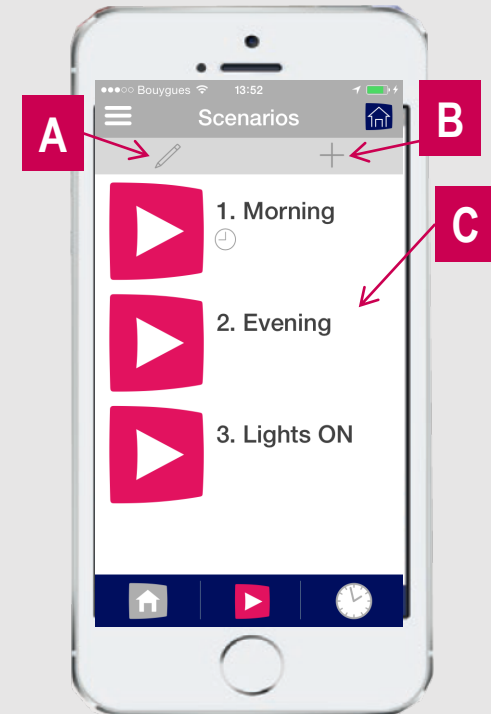

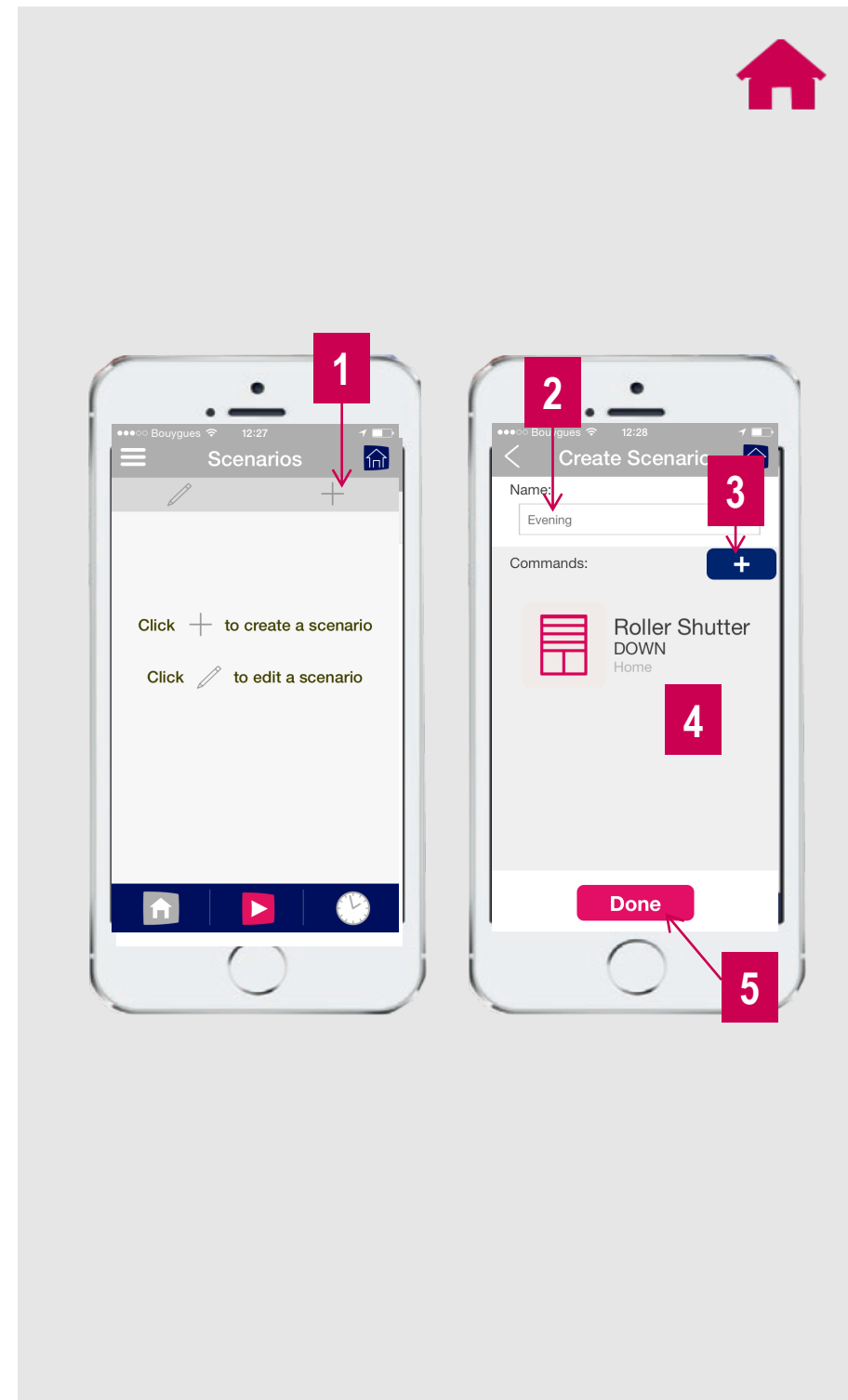
## 4. LiveIn use

### Create scenarios

(Max 25 characters will appear)
- 3 Add the desired commands one after the other
- 4 Here is the list of included commands in the scenario  
Ex. Scenario evening = Down command on shutter SAM
- 5 Click “done” to record the scenario



Creating scenarios is fundamental so as to use full functionality of LiveIn solution.  
Indeed, the schedule function use scenarios to program them on a week



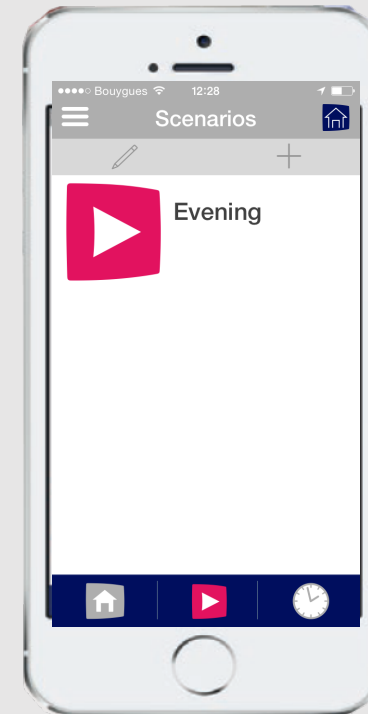
## 4. LiveIn use

### Play manually

- From the scenario menu, click on the scenario you want to play



Remember that you can always automate this scenario using the schedule function



## 4. LiveIn use

### Edit scenarios

**1** Click on  to enter in an edit mode

**2** Click on the scenario you want to change

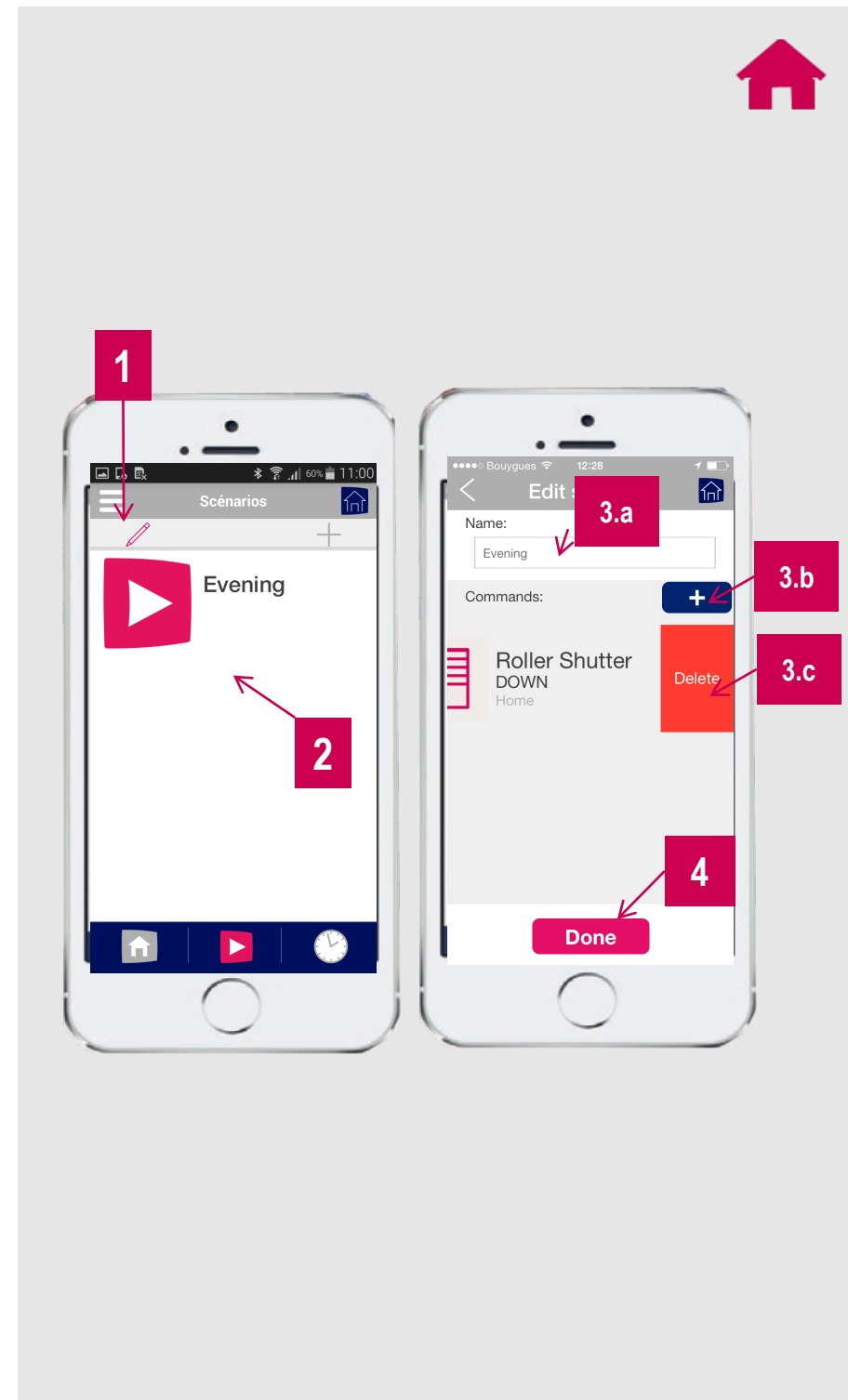
**3** You can then change this scenario

**a.** Change its name

**b.** Add a command (+)


**c.** Delete a command (drag left / delete)

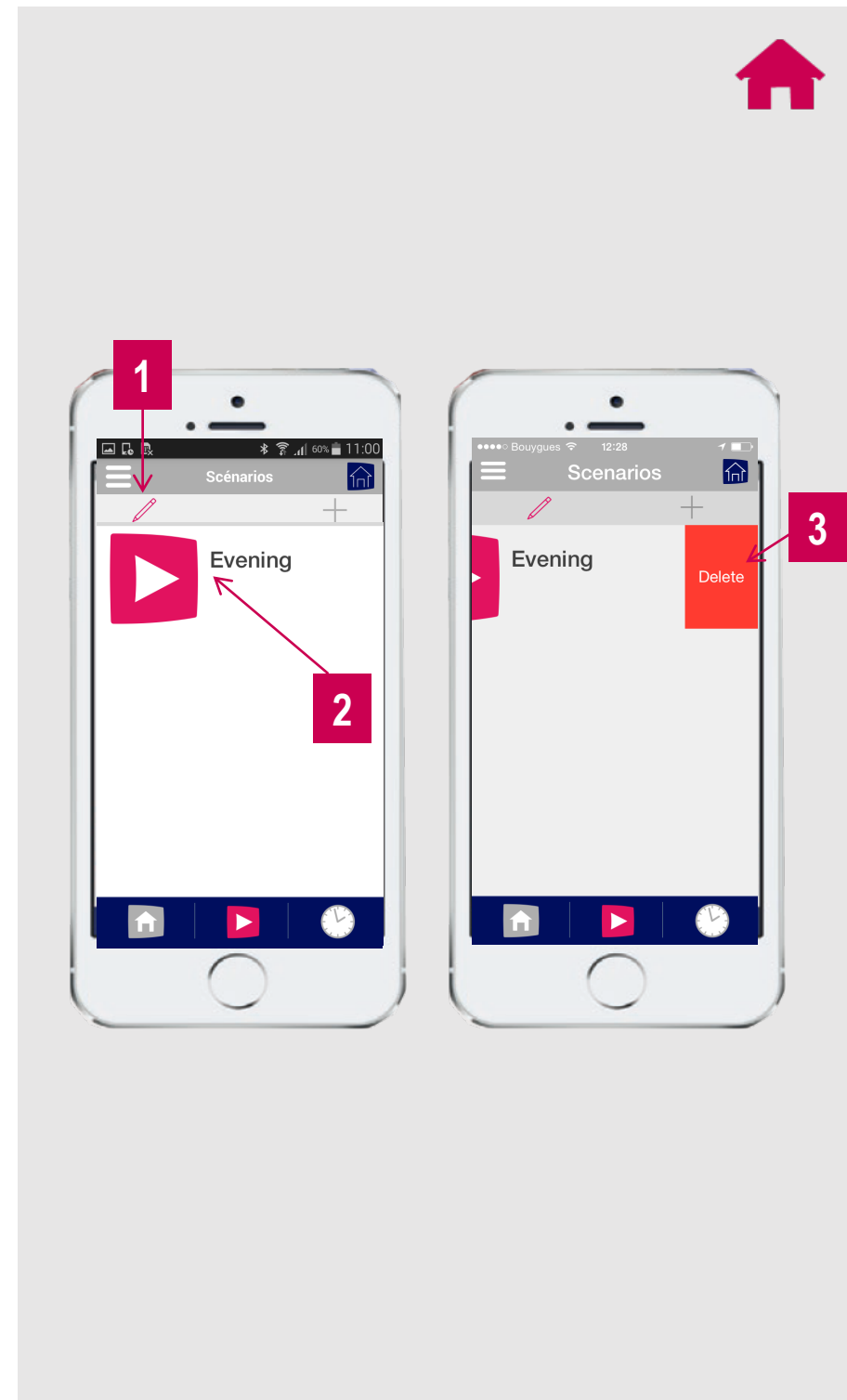

- 3 Confirm the deletion by pressing the delete button that appears



Take care that a scenario programmed on a schedule  
(Pictogram clock appears)



will not be deleted directly. You will need first to remove it from schedules  
in which it is included.

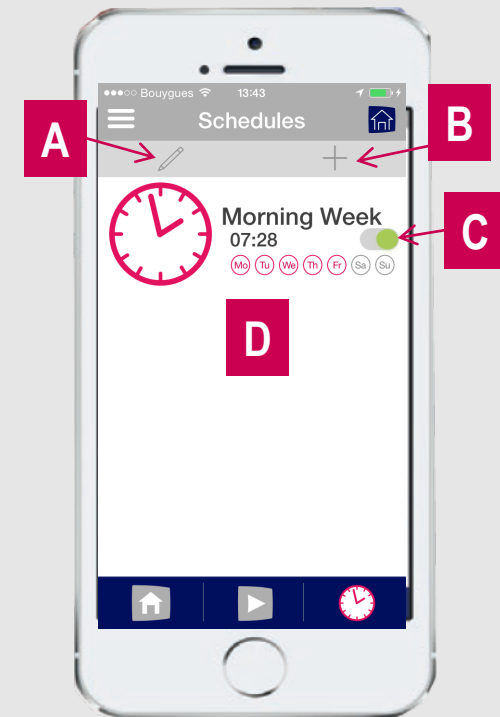

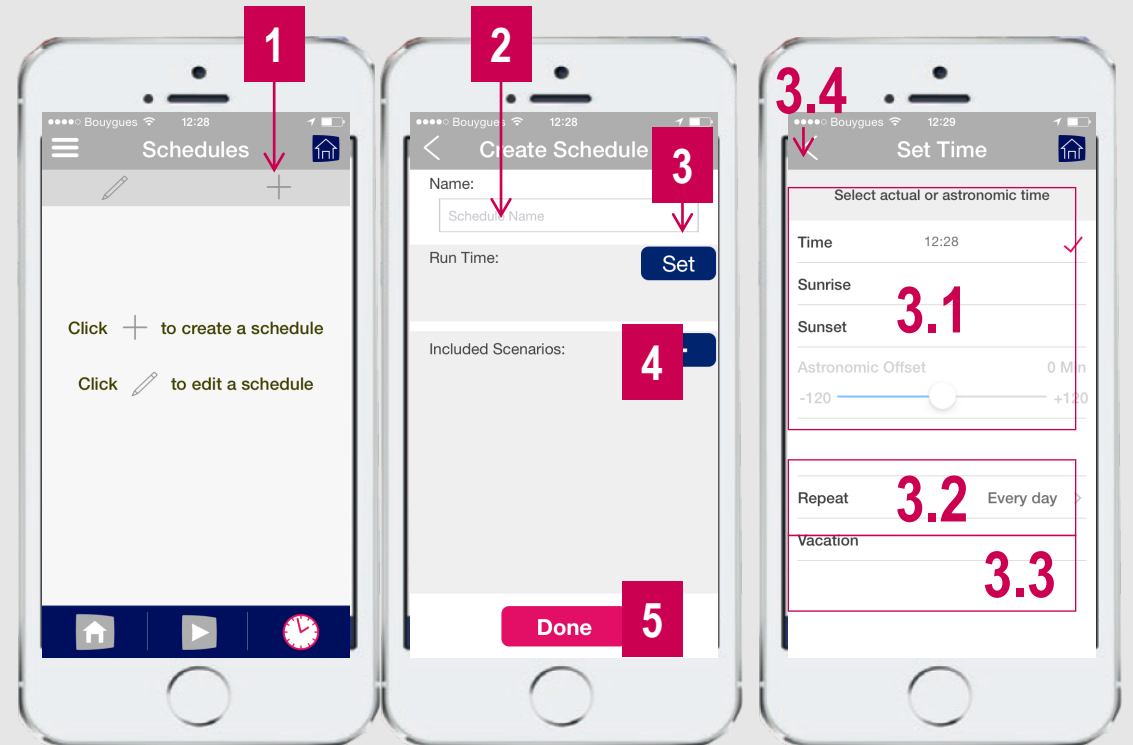

- 4** Include the scenario(s)
- 5** Click "done" to record the schedule

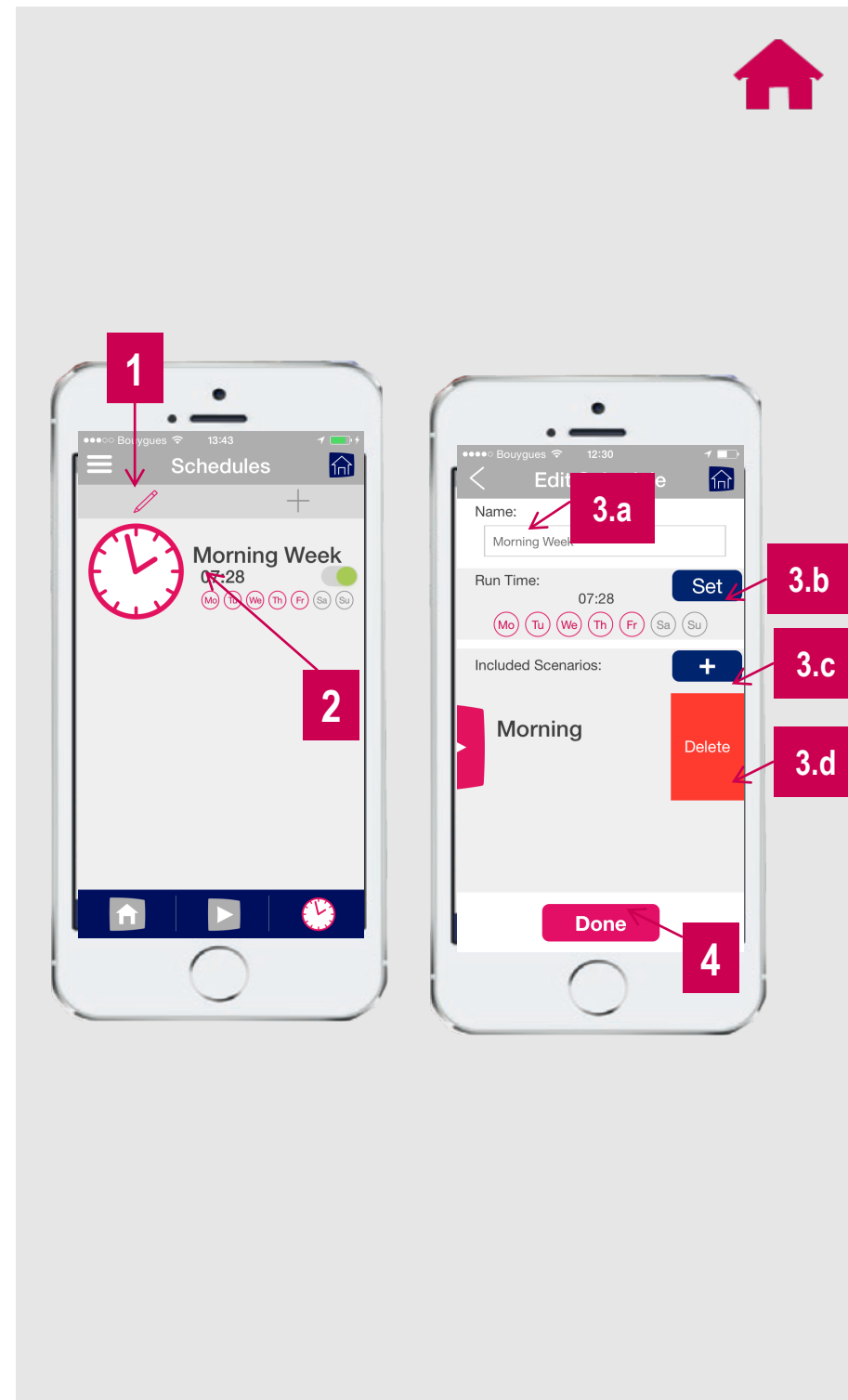


Enable geolocation on Live app In will allow better precision on the dusk and dawn

## 4. LiveIn use


### Edit a schedule

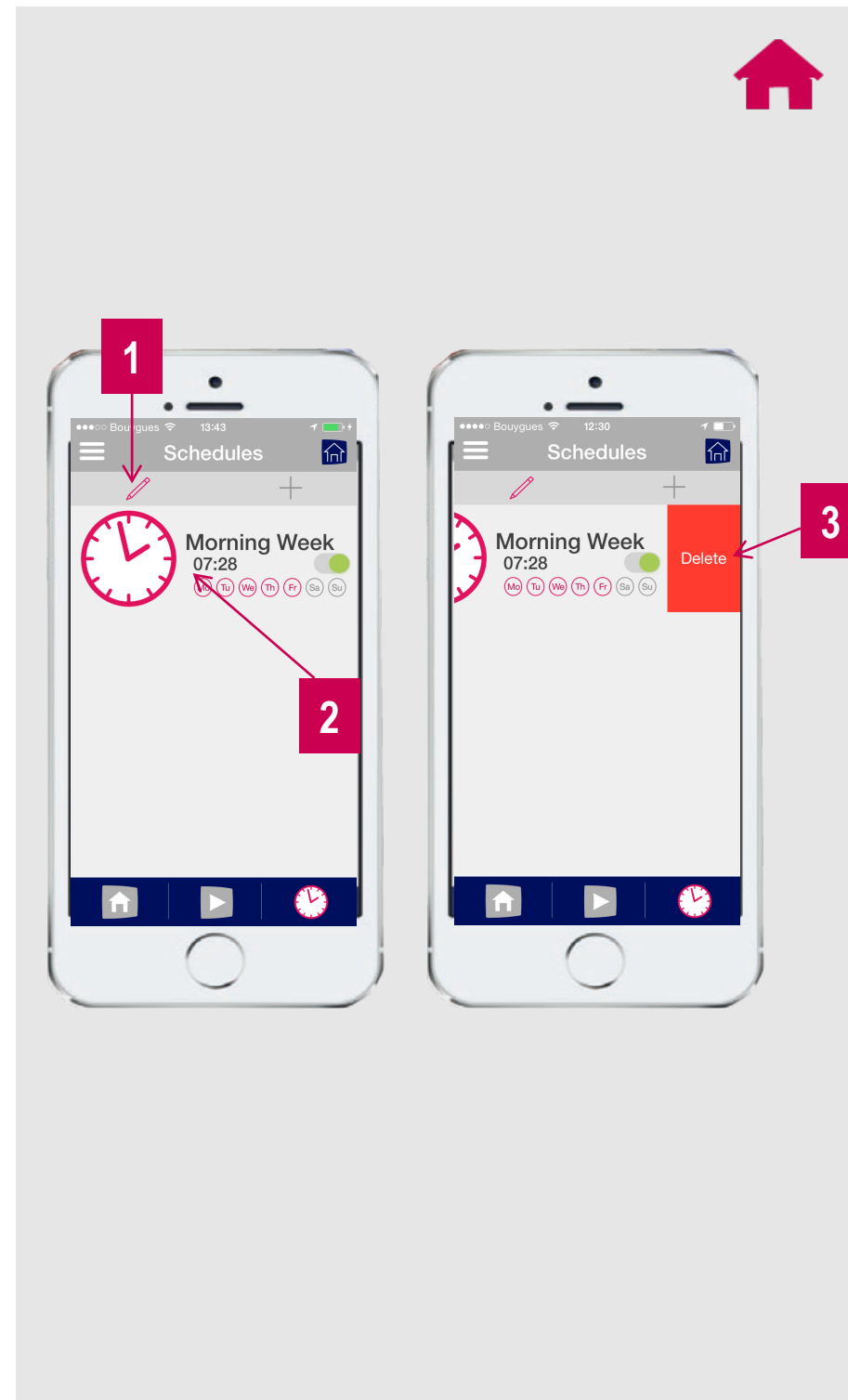
- 1** Click on  to enter in an edit mode
- 2** Click on the schedule you want to change
- 3** You can change this schedule
  - a.** Change its name
  - b.** Change its run time/days (set)
  - c.** Add a scenario (+)
  - d.** Delete a scenario (drag left / delete)
- 4** Confirm the change by clicking “done”

### Delete a schedule

- 1** Click on  to enter in an edit mode
- 2** Slide left the schedule
- 3** Confirm the deletion by pressing the delete button that appears



## 4. LiveIn use

### Add new users

#### Beforehand

- Get the PIN code of LiveIn installation
- Download LiveIn app on your mobile device
- Connect the mobile device to the same WiFi network as the LiveIn

**1** Click “Join existing LiveIn”

**2** Type the PIN code of LiveIn

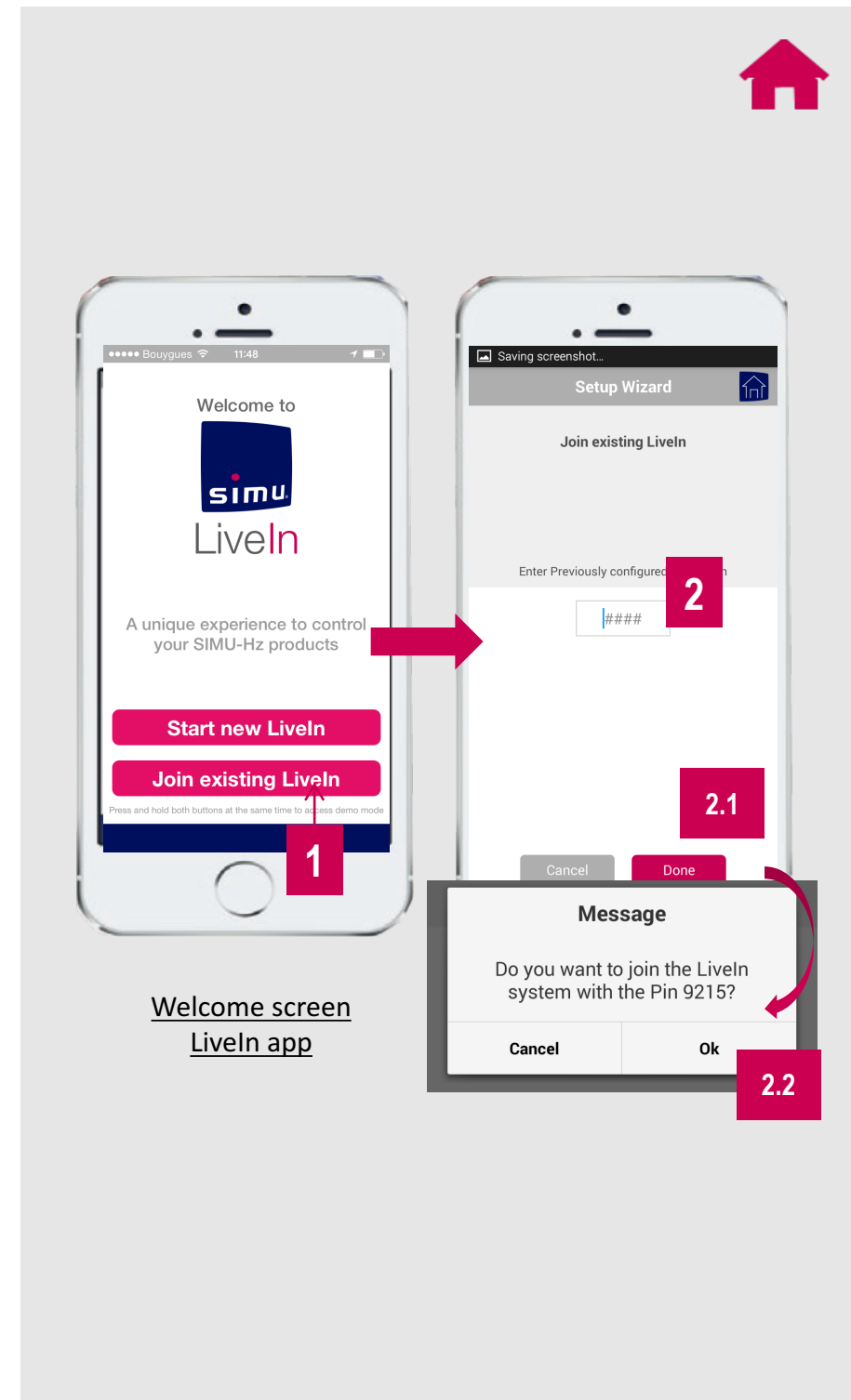
1. Then click “done”

2. Then click “OK”

- The new mobile device now has access to LiveIn installation with the same rights as others



You can also use  
« main menu/ Mobile PIN/ Share mobile Pin » that sends an email to the new user with the procedure and the PIN to join your installation.

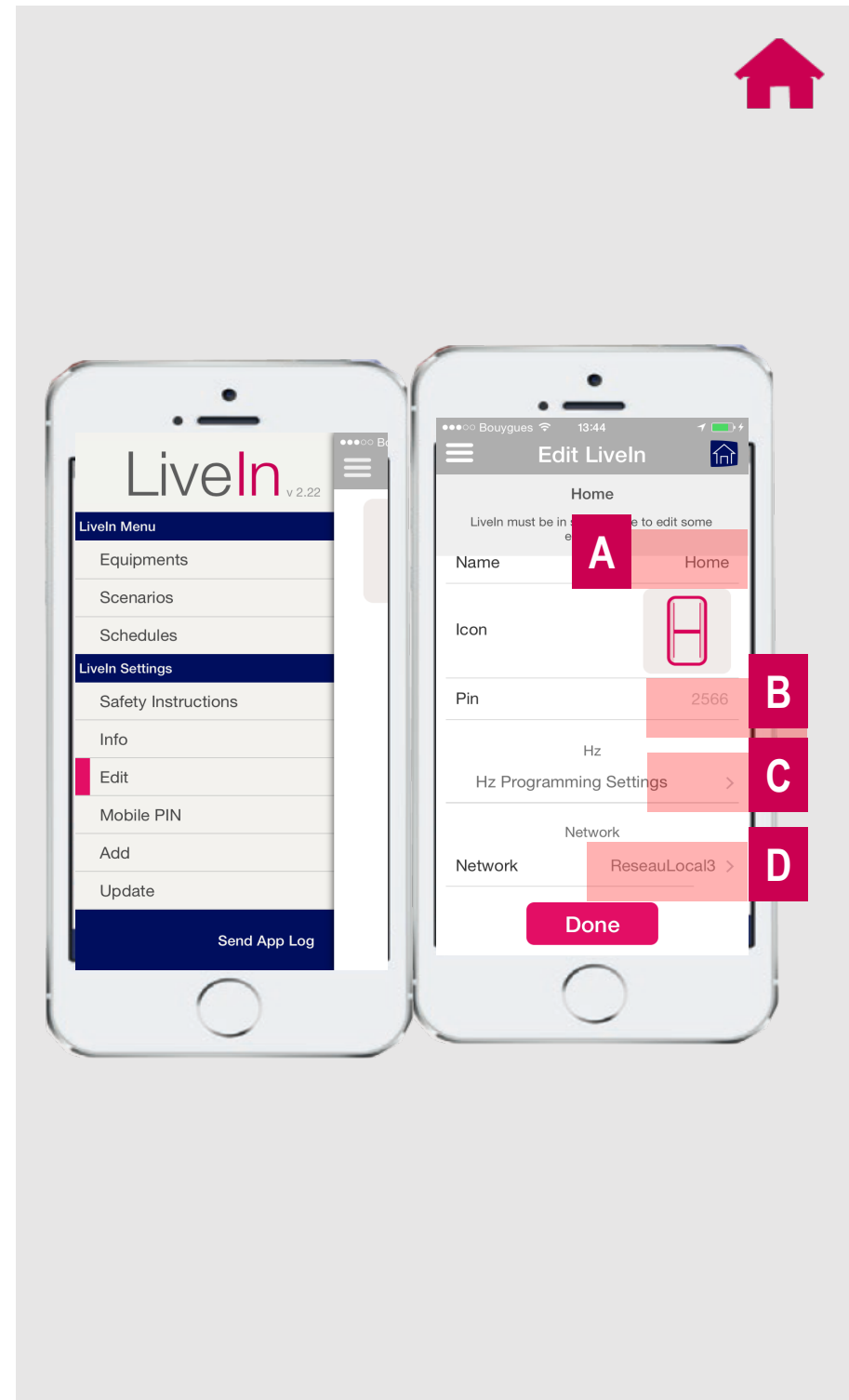


## 4. LiveIn use

### Change the settings of LiveIn plug

➤ In main menu, “Edit”, you can do the following modifications :

- A** Rename the plug
- B** Change PIN code  
*Warning : Only possible in configuration mode*
- C** Access the list of equipments to Add/change/suppress Simu-Hz equipments of LiveIn  
*Warning : Only for installers*
- D** Change WiFi network  
*Warning : Only possible in configuration mode*





## 4. LiveIn use

### Change PIN code of my installation

- PIN code of your LiveIn installation is a 4-digit PIN LiveIn generated automatically when the unit is configured.
- You can see it either in the main menu,
  - « Edit » : PIN
  - « Mobile PIN » : Current mobile PIN
- PIN code can only be changed in configuration mode of the plug

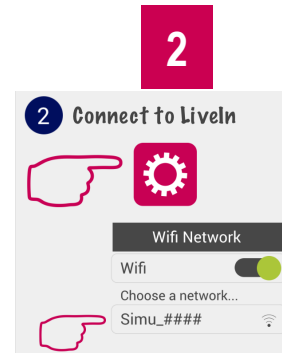


Any time you change your PIN, you will have to share it with all other users

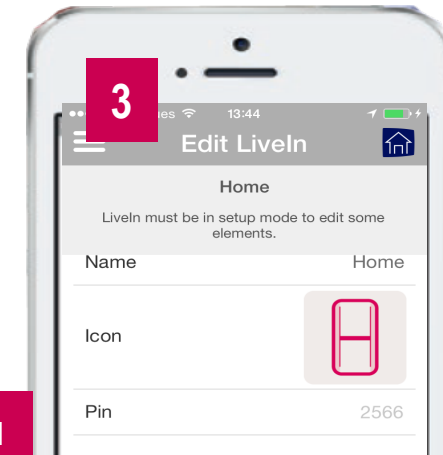
**1** Reset the LiveIn plug  
Press on the reset button – LED steady red



**2** Connect to the WiFi network from the plug (Simu\_####) in your mobile device settings.

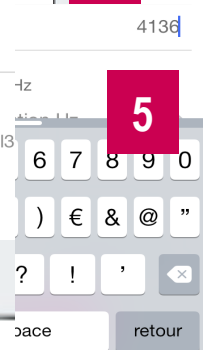

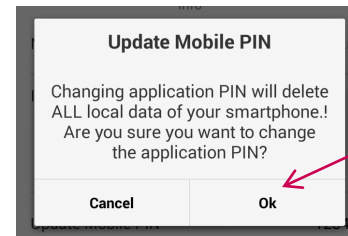


**4** Click on the digits of PIN code to bring up the keyboard

**5** Enter the new PIN code

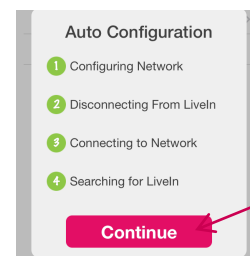

**1.** Click « OK » to confirm. All the settings of LiveIn are maintained

## 4. LiveIn use

### Change Wifi network of my installation

- The WiFi network of your installation has been configured when you first install the plug
- This WiFi network can only be changed in configuration mode of the plug

**1** Reset the LiveIn plug  
*Press on the reset button – LED steady red*

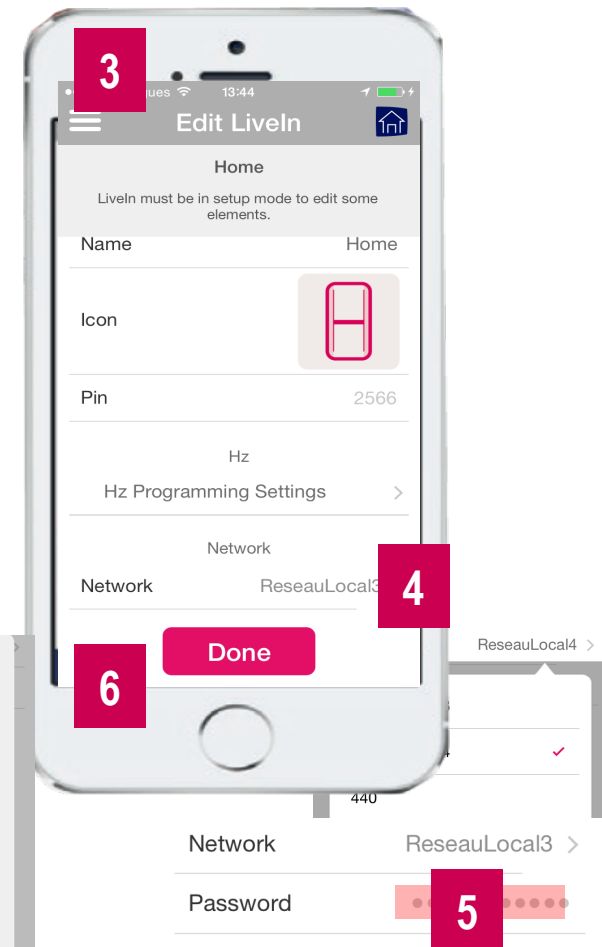


**2** Connect to the WiFi network from the plug (Simu\_####) in your mobile device settings.



**3** Then in main menu of the app, click “Edit”

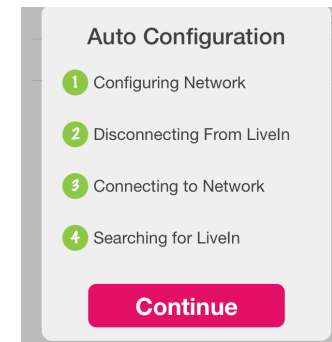
**4** Click on the current WiFi network to bring up the list of available networks and select the desired new network.



**5** Remember to enter the new network password

**6** Click « done » to record it

*Wait until the auto configuration is done and press continue to finish*

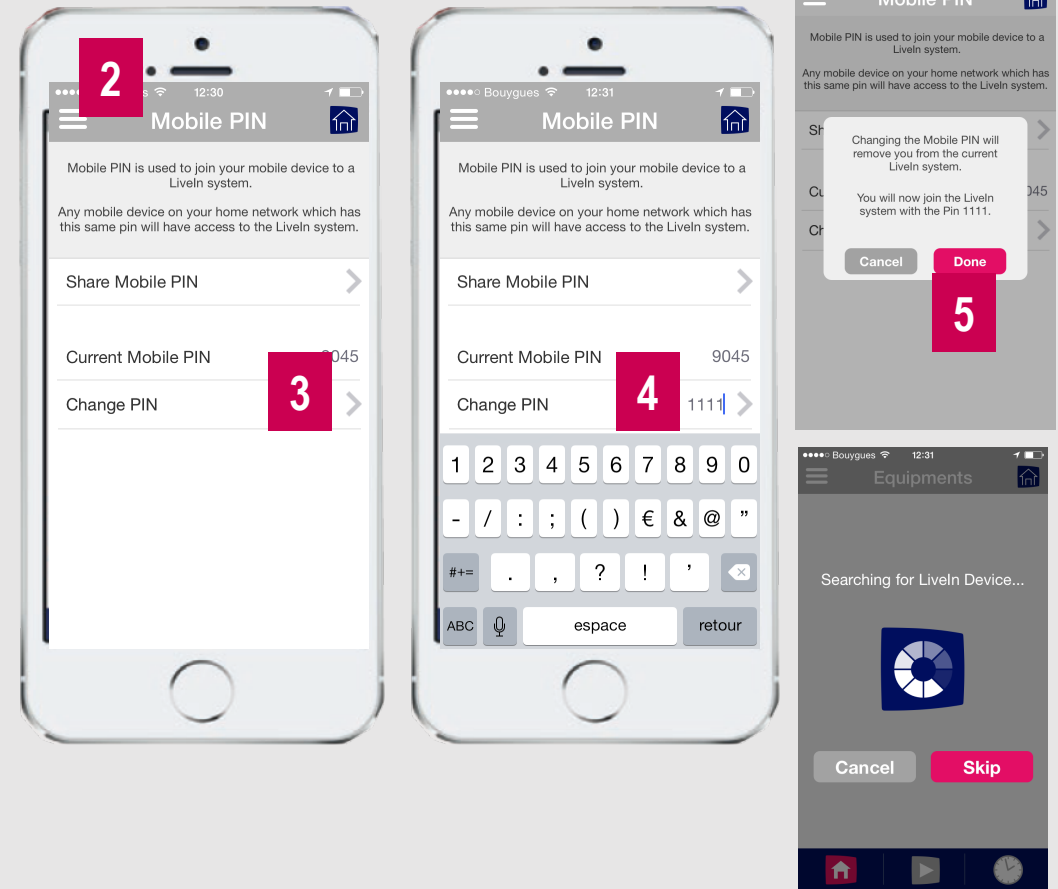
### Join another LiveIn installation


➤ A LiveIn installation is defined by:

- A 4-digit PIN code
- A WiFi network

➤ To join another LiveIn installation than yours :

- 1 Connect to the right WiFi network in your mobile device settings.
- 2 In main menu, click « mobile PIN »
- 3 Click « change Pin »
- 4 Enter the PIN code of the new installation
- 5 A warning message appears, Click « done »
- 6 A searching screen appears, Wait until the search is done.



 Then, you can for instance enjoy 2 LiveIn installations separated to each other

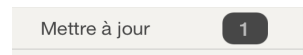


## 4. LiveIn use

### Update my installation

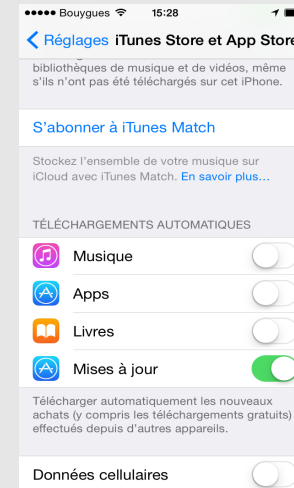
- LiveIn solution may propose some updates :
  - Of the application
  - Of the firmware of the plug
  
- For app updates, these ones will be done accordingly your mobile device settings :
  - Automatically, if the automatic download option "updates" is activated
  - Manually, otherwise
  
- If updates to the firmware are then available, these will appear in the main menu, "update"

**1** From the main menu, go to "update"

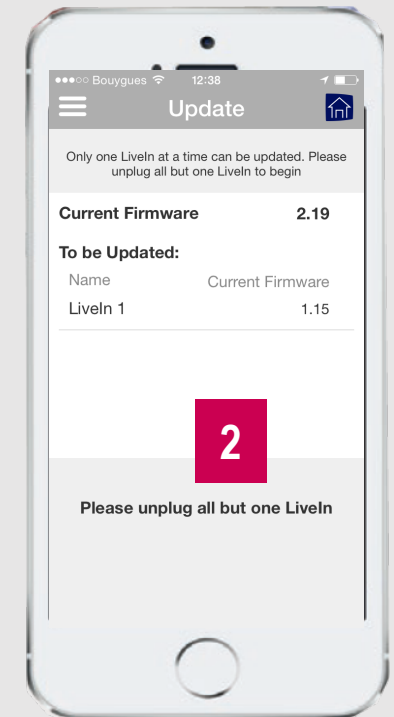
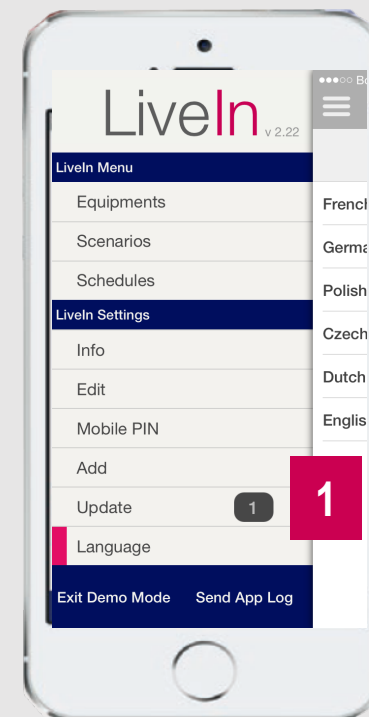


**2** If your installation has multiple plugs, unplug all but one.

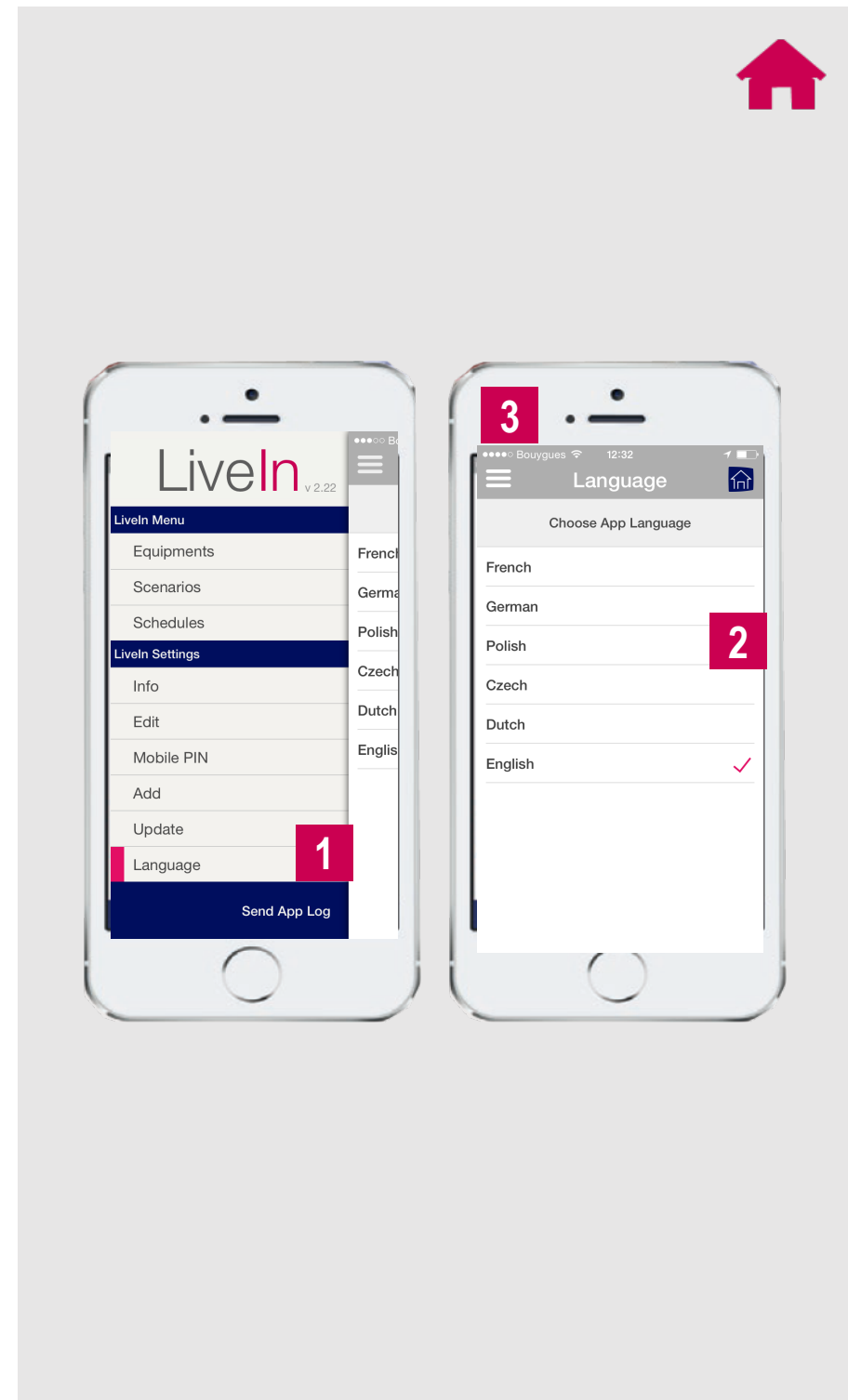

## 5. Advanced settings

### Add/ edit/ delete Simu-Hz equipments

#### >Understand how it works

- Each LiveIn plug may contain up to 25 channels
- 1 channel can contain a device or a group of devices Simu-Hz
- Each channel consists of a unique address that will be learned in Simu-Hz equipment through the process of pairing prog-prog
- =>Same as a transmitter
- The only way to remove the LiveIn from memory of equipment will therefore to do the reverse procedure prog-prog
- =>Same as a transmitter



A plug that would have been reset without doing this prog/prog to de-program the LiveIn/Motor link will still be in memory of the Simu-Hz equipments  
=> High risk if new programming performed on the same equipments





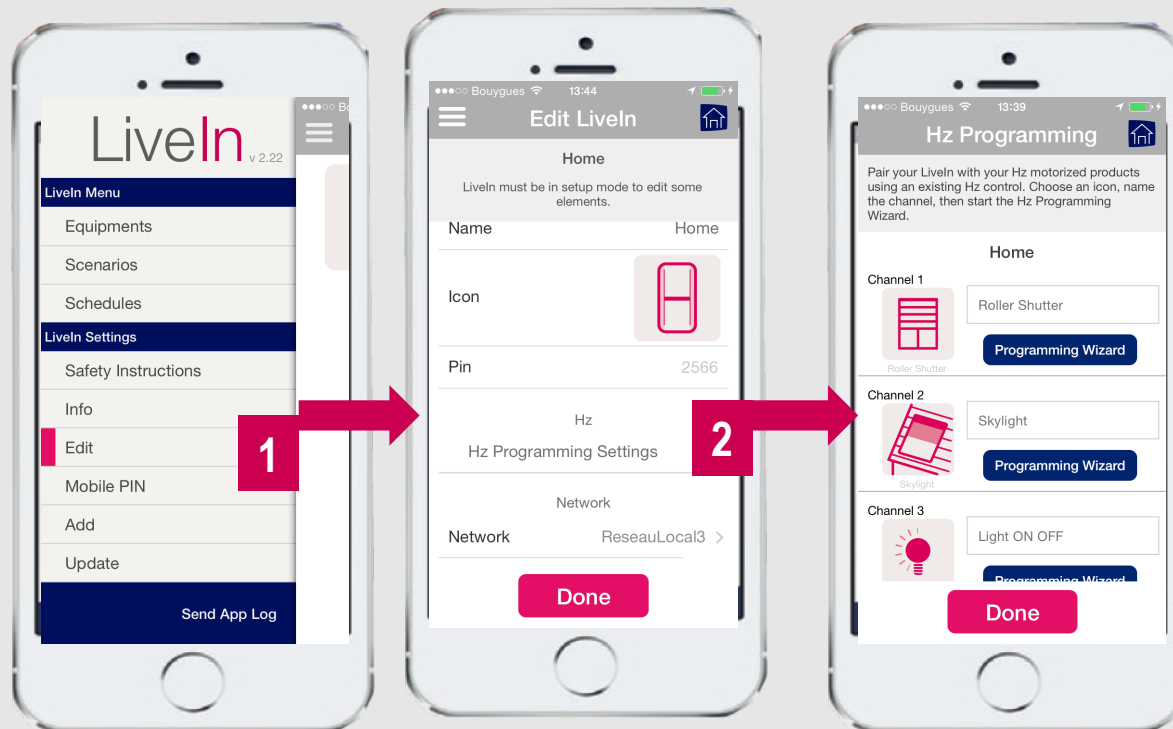
## 5. Advanced settings

Add/ edit/ delete Simu-Hz equipments

### > Return to the list of equipments

**1** Go to main menu, click « Edit »


**2** Click « Hz programming » to go back to the list of your equipments

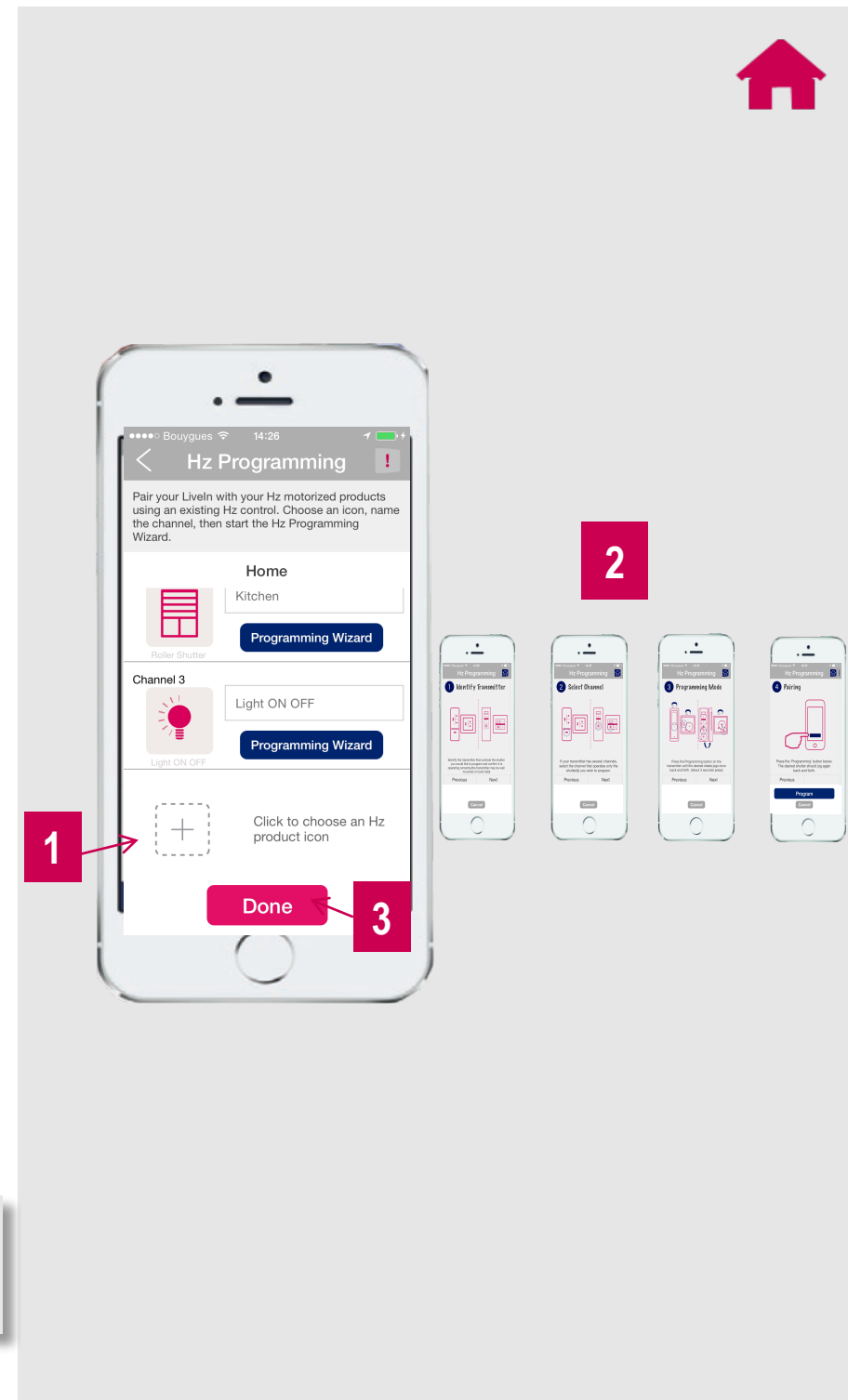
Add/ edit/ delete Simu-Hz equipments

### > Add a channel

- 1 Click  that is at the bottom of the list of your current equipments
- 2 Follow the setup wizard  
For details, see section “programming the Simu-Hz equipment (1st installation)”
- 3 To definitively validate the list of your equipment, press the “done” button.



It is important that the validation is done by either the done button at the bottom of the screen or the back button “save these changes, OK”

**1** The button **Programming Wizard** allows to edit the channel and change the included equipment(s)

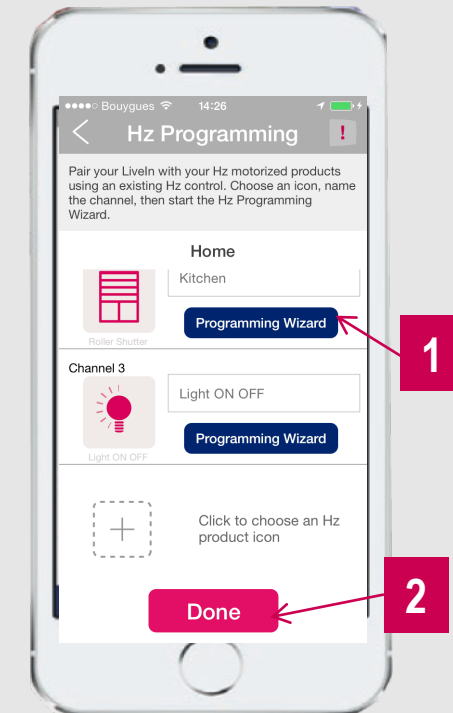
A. You can choose to add a new device on the channel following the programming assistant

1. Opening of the motor memory of the equipment to add
2. Press “program” LiveIn

B. You can remove a device from the channel following the programming assistant that will serve to de-program the LiveIn/Motor link

1. Opening of the motor memory of the equipment to delete
2. Press “program” LiveIn will delete the existing link with the motor

**2** To definitively validate the list of your equipment, press the “done” button.



## 5. Advanced settings

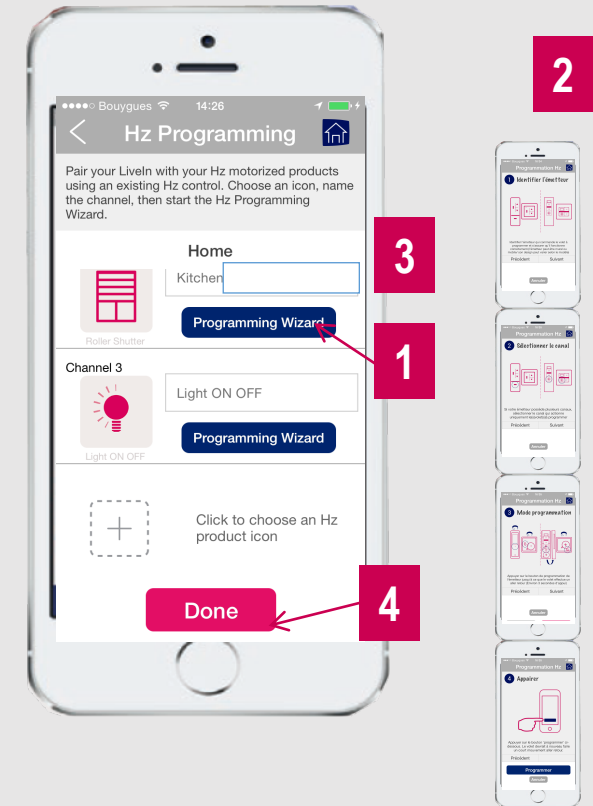
Add/ edit/ delete Simu-Hz equipments

### > Delete a channel

- 1 The button **Programming Wizard** allows to edit the channel
- 2 Delete the recorded equipment(s) following the programming assistant that will serve to de-program the LiveIn/Motor link  
Opening of the motor memory of the equipment to delete  
Press “program” LiveIn will delete the existing link with the motor
- 3 Completely erase the channel name
- 4 To definitively validate the list of your equipment, press the “done” button.



A deleted channel will be the first to be affected in the next channel creation process





## 5. Advanced settings

### Add a new LiveIn plug

➤ A LiveIn installation may contain up to 5 LiveIn plugs

➤ To add a new LiveIn plug on your existing installation :

**1** Go to main menu, click « Add »

**2** You are returned to the configuration wizards (such as at a first installation):

1. To configure the WiFi network
2. To program the Simu-Hz equipments



An installation LiveIn may include several LiveIn plugs with the same PIN, but on different WiFi networks (eg home & office). The two networks will need to have however the Internet access to communicate remotely to another system



## 5. Advanced settings

### Resetting a LiveIn plug

➤ A LiveIn plug can be totally reset that is to say: Erasing data network WiFi, data equipment, scenarios and schedules

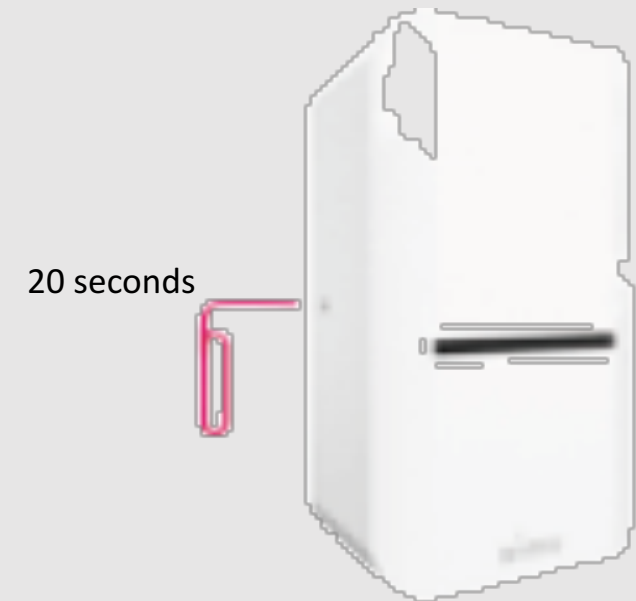
=>Back in his factory mode



**WARNING** : this reset does not erase LiveIn plug from memory of Simu-Hz equipments to which it was paired

➤ To reset a plug that will be reinstalled in the same place:

1. Do the procedure of de-programming the motor (see delete a channel)
  2. THEN press on the reset button for more than 20 seconds
- The LED is blank.



### Wifi network problems – Failure on auto configuration screen

	Motor is no longer fonctionnal	You can check it using another transmitter than LiveIn and see if the motor works well; If this is not the case, do maintenance on your motor.
	Motor is out of range of LiveIn plug	Check your installation environment. Are there any new disrupters for Simu-Hz communications? => Remove the disruptive elements => Move LiveIn plug closer to the motor checking the proper functioning of the entire system => Start an installation with multiple LiveIn plugs

### Other problems— I forgot my code PIN and I can't join anymore my installation

#### ➤ Possible cause :

➤ I chose to access another installation « Main menu / mobile PIN/ Change PIN and I forgot to note the PIN code of my own installation

#### ➤ Solution :

- 1 Reload the LiveIn app to start a new installation
- 2 Reset the LiveIn plug (Press on the reset button – LED steady red)
- 3 Connect to the WiFi network from the plug (Simu\_####) in your mobile device settings.
- 4 Click “search for LiveIn”
- 5 Select the wifi network
- 6 Type again your wifi password to ensure it is the correct one
- 7 Validate with “next”
- 8 Wait until the auto configuration is done and press continue to finish
- 9 The message “livein is already configured” appears\_Press continue to come back to the configuration made in factory.The installer retrieve all the configuration. He just needs to validate the name and then the screen with Simu-Hz equipments to go back to user mode

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
